PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1949.

Prices Control Order No. 312.

Meat.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, George Robert Marshall Garratt, Delegate of the Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following order:—

#### Citation.

- 1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 312.
- 2. Prices Control Order No. 283, as amended by Prices Control Order No. 297, is hereby further amended—
  - (a) by omitting from paragraph 3 thereof the definition of the "Perth Metropolitan Area" and inserting in its stead the following:
    "Perth Metropolitan Area" means all that

'Perth Metropolitan Aren' means all that area comprised within a radius of 25 miles from the General Post Office, Perth;

- (b) by omitting the First Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the First Schedule to this order:
- (c) by omitting the Third Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the Second Schedule to this order.
