PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1949.

Prices Control Order No. 320.

School Stationery Books-Sales by Retail. IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:

Citation.

1. This Order may be eited as Prices Control Order No. 320.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 282 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order and the Schedules thereto, unless the contrary intention appears-

- "'Perth Metropolitan Area'' means all that area of the State of Western Australia comprised within a radius of 12 miles from the General Post Office, at Perth.
- "Allowance for cost of transport" means, in relation to the sale of any specified goods, the allowance set forth in the second column of the Second Schedule to this Order.
- "Cost of transport" means, in relation to the sale of any specified goods, the cost of trans-porting such goods from the point of delivery to the store of the retail seller by the cheap-est form of transport available.
- "Point of delivery" means, in relation to the sale by retail of any specified goods, the price at which liability for payment of transport charges in conveying those goods to his place of business passed to the seller by retail from the person from whom the seller by retail purchased such goods.
- "Specified goods" means any of the goods speci-fied in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order.

Maximum Retail Prices.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the specified goods of the types or descrip-tions set forth in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by any person by retail to be-

- (a) in respect of sales within the Perth Metropolitan Area, the price set out in the second column of such Schedule;
- (b) in respect of sales outside the Perth Metropolitan Area, the sum of-
 - (i) the price set out in the second column of such schedule;
 - (ii) allowance per book for cost of trans-Second Schedule to this Order according to the cost of transport set out in the first column of such Schedule.

Exhibition of Price Tickets.

5. (1) Every person who has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall attach to or display with those goods a ticket or label setting forth his selling price thereof.

(2) Any ticket or label required by subparagraph (1) of this paragraph to be attached to or displayed with any goods shall be in such form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or viewing those goods and as to be properly associated with such goods.

Discounts.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, where a seller of any of the goods specified in this Order by retail has customarily allowed any difference in price-

- (a) to any person or to persons included in any class of persons;
- (b) in respect of sales of certain quantities of those goods; or

(c) in respect of sales of such goods under certain conditions of sale, or upon certain terms of payment,

the maximum price fixed by or under this Order in respect of those goods shall, in the case of sales to any such person or persons or of such quantities or under such conditions or upon such terms of payment, be reduced by the allowance of that difference.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

7. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any goods a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order and which are specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Ice-Retail Sales-Perth Metropolitan Area.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 321.

Definition.

2. In this Order "Perth Metropolitan Area" means all that area of Western Australia comprised within a radius of 50 miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

Sales by Retail.

3. I fix and declare the maximum price at which ice of any weight specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail by any person in the Perth Metropolitan Area to be the price set out opposite such weight in the second column of the Schedule.

4. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any ice specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to such person.

The Laying and Construction from Sandstone of Foundations for Dwelling Houses.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 322.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order, No. 75, as amended by Prices Control Order No. 220, is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

- (a) in relation to sales of sandstone, 27 cubic feet:
- (b) in relation to the laying or construction of foundations for dwelling houses, 16 cubic feet.

Maximum Prices-Sandstone.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which sandstone may be sold by any person for delivery to any building site situated in any of the municipal districts or road board districts specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order, to be the price set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite the name of such municipal district or road board district.

Maximum Rates-Supply of Sandstone and the Laying or Construction therefrom of Sandstone Foundations.

5. I fix and declare the maximum rate at which any person may supply the service of supplying sandstone and from such sandstone, laying or constructing foundations for dwelling houses upon any building site situated in any of the municipal districts or road board districts specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order, to be the rate, according to the average height of stone, set out in the second or third or fourth column of that schedule opposite the name of such municipal district or road board district.

Variation of Maximum Prices or Rates by Notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, wherein any notice in writing to any person in pursuance of this paragraph a maximum price is fixed in relation to the sale of sandstone, or a maximum rate is fixed for the supply of the service of supplying sandstone and from such sandstone the laying or construction of foundations for dwelling houses, I declare the maximum price at which such specified goods may be sold, or the maximum rate at which such specified service may be supplied, to be such price or rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:---

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 325.

2. Prices Control Order No. 270 as amended by Prices Control Order No. 276 is hereby further amended-

(a) by omitting paragraph 4 thereof as amended and inserting in its stead the following:—

Sales by Millers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato and pollato may be sold by wholesale by millers to be—

- (a) delivered at mill door, ex mill store, or at mill siding-
 - (i) in respect of brau or pollard— £12 17s. 0d. per short ton;
 - (ii) in respect of flaky brau-£13 7s. 0d. per short ton;

- (iii) in respect of ground wheat, branato or pollato—£16 3s. 9d. per short ton;
- (b) delivered in truck lots of six long tous at any railway station or siding other than the mill siding-
 - (i) in respect of bran or pollard—the appropriate price per short ton specified in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order;
 - (ii) in respect of flaky brau—the appropriate price per short ton specified in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order for bran or pollard, plus 10s. per short ton;
 - (iii) in respect of ground wheat, branato, or pollato—the appropriate price per short ton specified in the third column of the First Schedule to this Order;
- (c) delivered in less than truck lots of six long tons at any railway station or siding other than the mill siding—the maximum price specified in sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph, plus the rail freight chargeable for the transport of the bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato, as the case may be, from the nuill siding nearest to the purchaser's railway station or siding;
 - - (i) in respect of bran or pollard— £12 17s. 0d. per short fon; in respect of flaky bran—£13 7s. 0d. per short tou; in respect of ground wheat, branato or pollato—£16 3s. 9d. per short tou;
 - (ii) cost of cartage from rail to wharf actually incurred but not exceeding 5s. per short ton;
 - (iii) wharfage, loading aud other charges actually incurred at port of shipment, and;
 - (iv) sea freight payable on the consigument:

Provided that where such brau, pollard, flaky ,bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato is sold in quautities of not less thau six long tons, and the maximum prices fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be subject to a reduction of 5s. per short ton for cash.

- (b) by the addition of the amount of £1 10s. 6d. to each of the prices set forth in the Second Column of the First Schedule to the Order;
- (c) by the addition of the amount of £2 4s. 0d. to each of the prices set forth in the Third Column of the Schedule to the Order;
