PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1950.

Prices Control Order No. 518.

Bran, Pollard, Flaky Bran, Ground Wheat, Branato and Pollato.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:---

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 518.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 270 as amended by Prices Control Orders Nos. 276, 325 and 425 is hereby revoked.

Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order and the Schedule thereto, unless the contrary intention appears— $\!\!\!$

"short ton" means 2,000lb.;

"long ton" means 2,240lb.;

"bushel" means 20lb.;

- "North-West port" means any port in Western Australia North of the 26th parallel of South latitude;
- "wholesale" means in relation to bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato that such bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato is sold to the purchaser for the purposes of re-sale, and "wholesale" shall also be deemed to apply to sales to users who purchase at each delivery a total of not less than 1 short ton;
- "retail" means in relation to bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato, that such sale is not a sale by wholesale as defined in the preceding clause of this paragraph;

"for cash" means in relation to any sale that payment is made as follows:—

- (a) Where the purchaser's premises are within 20 miles of the flour mill or the seller's store—within 7 days of delivery; or
- (b) where the purchaser's premises are beyond 20 miles and within 100 miles of the flour mill or the seller's store—within 10 days of delivery; or
- (c) where the purchaser's premises are more than 100 miles from the flour mill or the seller's store—within 14 days of delivery; or
- (d) where the purchaser's premises are situated North of Carnarvon—by the first postal mail following the receipt of the goods;
- "Shark Bay area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Shark Bay;
- "Carnarvon area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Carnarvon;
- "Broome area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Broome;
- "Onslow area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Onslow;
- "Port Hedland area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Port Hedland;
- "Roebourne area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 10 miles from the principal post office at Roebourne;

- "Derby area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 6 miles from the principal post office at Derby;
- "Yampi area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 5 miles from the principal post office at Yampi;
- "Wyndham area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 6 miles from the principal post office at Wyndham;
- "Marble Bar area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the prin-cipal post office at Marble Bar;
- "Nullagine area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 20 miles from the prin-cipal post office at Nullagine;
- "Wittenoom Gorge area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Wittenoom Gorge;
- "Noonkanbah area" means that portion of the state comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Noonkanbah;
- "Fitzroy Crossing area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Fitzroy Crossing;
- "Halls Creek area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the prin-cipal post office at Halls Creek;
- "Turkey Creek area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the prin-cipal post office at Turkey Creek.

Sales by Millers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato and pollato may be sold by wholesale by millers to be-

- (a) delivered at mill door, ex mill store, or at mill siding-
 - (i) in respect of bran or pollard— £14 19s. per short ton;
 (ii) in respect of flaky bran—£15 9s. per
 - short ton;
 - (iii) in respect of ground wheat, branato or pollato-£18 1s. 9d. per short ton;
- (b) delivered in truck lots of 8 long tons at any railway station or siding other than the mill siding-
 - (i) in respect of bran or pollard—the appropriate price per short ton specified in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order;
 - (ii) in respect of flaky bran—the appro-priate price per short ton specified in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order for bran or pollard, plus 10s. per short ton;
 - (iii) in respect of ground wheat, branato or pollato-the appropriate price per short ton specified in the third column of the First Schedule to this Order:
- (c) delivered in less than truck lots of 8 long tons at any railway station or siding other than the mill siding-the maximum price specified in subparagraph (a) of this paragraph, plus the rail freight chargeable for the transport of the bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato, as the case may be, from the mill siding nearest to the purchaser's railway station or siding;
- (d) when sold for shipment to any North-West port—the sum of the following:—

 (i) In respect of bran or pollard—
 £14 19s. per short ton; in respect of flaky bran—£15 9s. per short ton; in respect of ground wheat, branato or pollato—£18 1s. 9d. per short ton;

- (ii) cost of cartage from rail to wharf actually incurred but not exceeding 5s. per short ton;
- (iii) wharfage, loading and other charges actually incurred at port of shipment; and
- (iv) sea freight payable on the consignment:

Provided that where such bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato is sold in quantities of not less than eight long tons, the maximum prices fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be subject to a reduction of 5s. per short ton for cash.

Other Wholesale Sales.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato may be sold by wholesale other than by a miller to be the maximum prices fixed by the provisions of subparagraphs (a) or (b) of paragraph 4 of this Order, as the case may be, for the sale of those goods by wholesale by a miller, plus transportation charges actually in-curred by a wholesale seller but not exceeding 5s. per ton in placing such bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato in the wholesale seller's store, plus the following margins:—

- (a) For delivery ex store or on rails, or otherwise except to purchaser's premises—at the rate of 10s. per short ton.
- (b) For delivery to the purchaser's premises —at the rate of 22s. 6d. per short ton.
- (c) In places North of the 26th parallel of South latitude—the price at Fremantle or Geraldton, as the case may be, in accord-ance with the prices specified in the First Schedule to this Order for sales at Fre-mantle or Geraldton (as the case may be), plus transportation and loading charges actually incurred by the wholesale seller in delivering such bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato to the purchaser, plus margin at the rate of 15s. per short ton.

Sales by Retail.

6. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato may be sold by retail to be-

- (a) in places South of the 26th parallel of South latitude-the maximum price fixed South latitude—the maximum price fixed by the provisions of paragraphs 4 or 5 of this Order, as the case may be, for the sale of those goods, plus cartage actually incurred by the retail seller, but not ex-ceeding 5s. per ton, in placing such bran, pollard, fiaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato in the retail seller's store, plus the margins specified in the Second Schedule to this Order: Schedule to this Order;
- (b) in places North of the 26th parallel of South latitude—the maximum price fixed by the provision of paragraphs 4 or 5 of this Order, as the case may be, for the sale of those goods, plus cartage actually incurred in placing such bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato in the retail seller's store, plus the margins specified in the Third Schedule of this Order.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, where a maximum price is fixed by notice in writing to any person in relation to any bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato, the maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which such bran, pollard, flaky bran, ground wheat, branato or pollato may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is flxed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1950.

Prices Control Order No. 519.

Potatoes.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 519.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 365, as amended by Prices Control Order No. 430, is hereby revoked.

Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

- "cost into store of the retail seller" means the sum of the following:—
 - (a) The price paid or payable by the retail seller for the potatoes computed on the basis of the full weight of the potatoes, bag and any earth contained therein, and without any allowance for waste.
 - (b) Cost of transport actually incurred and properly attributable to conveying the potatoes from the point of delivery to the retail seller to that retail seller's store;
 - "cost of transport" means any cost of transport which is recorded on an invoice for the potatoes delivered to the retail seller;
 - "potatoes" means potatoes other than seed potatoes sold under permit from the Western Australian Potato Marketing Board;
 - "Perth Metropolitan Area" means all that part of Western Australia comprised within a radius of 12 miles from the General Post Office at Perth.

Sales by Growers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which potatoes may be sold by growers to be—

- (a) delivered ex railway truck, Perth Metropolitan area, £23 12s. 6d. per ton;
- (b) for deliveries at places other than the Perth Metropolitan Area, Kalgoorlie, Boulder or Geraldton, £23 12s. 6d. per ton at grower's siding, plus the cost of transport actually incurred by the grower and properly attributable to conveying the potatoes from the grower's railway station or siding to the point of delivery to the purchaser;
- (c) delivered ex railway truck at Kalgoorlie, Boulder or Gerdalton, £25 2s. 6d. per ton.

Sales by Wholesalers—Deliveries within Perth Metropolitan Area.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which potatoes may be sold by wholesale by any person other than a grower for delivery in the Perth Metropolitan Area to be the sum of—

- (a) £23 12s. 6d. per ton or the purchase price paid or payable by the wholesale seller, whichever is the lesser;
- (b) margin at the rate of 32s. 6d. per ton;

Provided that, if the seller, at the request of the purchaser, delivers the potatoes from his store—

- (a) to a railway station or siding—the price fixed by the foregoing provisions may be increased by 7s. 6d. per ton; or
- (b) to the premises of the purchaser—the price fixed by the foregoing provisions may be increased by 12s. 6d. per ton.

Sales by Wholesale—Deliveries outside Perth Metropolitan Area.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which potatoes may be sold by wholesale by any person other than the grower to be—

- (i) in respect of sales for delivery other than in the Perth Metropolitan Area, Kalgoorlie, Boulder, or Geraldton, £23 12s. 6d. per ton or the purchase price paid or payable by the wholesale seller, whichever is the lesser; plus cost of transport actually incurred by the seller and properly attributable to conveying the potatoes by rail from the loading station to the railway station or siding nearest the purchaser's premises; or
- (ii) in respect of sales for delivery in Kalgoorlie, Boulder or Geraldton, £25 2s. 6d. per ton, or the purchase price paid or payable by the wholesale seller, whichever is the lesser;
- (iii) plus in either case, a margin of-
 - (a) 12s. 6d. per ton for sales of truck lots where the purchase price is paid within 30 days of date of delivery, or
 - (b) 17s. 6d. per ton for sales of truck lots where the purchase price is not paid within 30 days of date of delivery, or
 - (c) 27s. 6d. per ton for sales of less than truck lots ex rail truck, or
 - (d) 32s. 6d. per ton for sales of less than truck lots ex wholesale store.

Provided that if the seller, at the request of the purchaser, delivers the potatoes from his store to the premises of the purchaser, the prices fixed by the foregoing provisions may be increased by 7s. 6d. per ton.

Sales by Retail—Specified Quantities.

7. I fix and declare the maximum price at which potatoes may be sold by any person by retail to be—

- (a) in respect of sales within the Perth Metropolitan Area of the quantities specified in the Second Schedule to this Order—
 - (i) the price specified therein according to the cost into store of the retail seller set out in the first column of that Schedule; or
 - (ii) the price specified for such quantities in the First Schedule;
 - whichever is the lesser;
- (b) in respect of sales in any place other than the Perth Metropolitan Area, of the quantities specified in the Second Schedule to this Order—the prices specified therein, according to the cost into store of the retail seller set out in the first column of that Schedule.

Sales by Retail—Unspecified Quantities.

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which potatoes may be sold by any person by retail in any quantity other than the quantities specified in the First and Second Schedules to this Order, to be a price which bears the same proportion to the maximum price fixed for 28 lb. of potatoes by the provisions of subparagraphs (a) or (b) of paragraph 7 of this Order, as the quantity bears to 28 lb.

In bags l

Sales by the Bag.

9. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which potatoes may be sold by any person by wholesale by the bag to be the maximum price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the sale of 149 lb. of potatoes, or the maximum price so fixed for the sale of the potatoes actually contained in the bag, whichever is the lesser.

Exhibition of Price Tickets.

10. Every person who sells or has for sale potatoes by retail shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, a notice or notices setting forth his selling price in relation to each lot of potatoes displayed by that person anywhere upon such place or places of business, in the following manner, that is to say, by exhibiting a prices card specifying the selling price applicable to each lot of such potatoes, displayed so as to properly associate such price with the lot of potatoes to which that price applies.

Variation of Maximum Price by Notice.

11. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any potatoes specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whim such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to such person.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 520.

2. Prices Control Order No. 265, as amended by Prices Control Order No. 323, is hereby revoked.

Prices Control Commissioner.

Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

- "Metropolitan Area" means the area served by the railway from South Beach and Fremantle to Midland Junction, and Perth to Cannington;
- "for cash" means in relation to any sale, that payment is made—
 - (a) where the purchaser's premises are within 20 miles of the flour mill or the seller's store—within 7 days of delivery; or
 - (b) where the purchaser's premises are beyond 20 miles and within 100 miles of the flour mill or the seller's store—within 10 days of delivery; or

- (c) where the purchaser's premises are more than 100 miles from the flour mill or the seller's store—within 14 days of delivery; or
- (d) where the buyer's premises are situated North of Carnarvon—by the first postal mail following the receipt of the goods;
- "purchaser's railway station or siding" means the railway station or siding most easy of access to the purchaser's premises;
- "North-Western port" means any port in Western Australia North of the 26th parallel of South latitude;
- "whole wheatmeal" means the product made by grinding sound wheat, and which contains in their natural proportions all the constituents of the cleaned grain;
- "standard wheatmeal" means wheatmeal milled or pounded so as to contain the gristed produce of cleaned and sound wheat mixed with wheaten flour in the proportion of 30 parts of the latter to 70 parts of the former;
- "short ton" means 2,000 lb.;

"long ton" means 2,240 lb.;

- "wholesale" means, in relation to plain flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal, that such plain flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal is sold to the purchaser for the purpose of re-sale;
- "retail" means, in relation to plain flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal, that such sale is not a sale by wholesale as defined in the preceding clause of this paragraph;
- "Shark Bay area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Shark Bay;
- "Carnarvon area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Carnarvon;
- "Broome area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Broome;
- "Onslow area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Onslow;
- "Port Hedland area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Port Hedland;
- "Roebourne area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 10 miles from the principal post office at Roebourne;
- "Derby area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 6 miles from the principal post office at Derby;
- "Yampi area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 5 miles from the principal post office at Yampi;
- "Wyndham area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 6 miles from the principal post office at Wyndham;
- "Marble Bar area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Marble Bar;
- "Nullagine area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 20 miles from the principal post office at Nullagine;
- "Wittenoom Gorge area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Wittenoom Gorge;

- "Noonkanbah area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Noonkanbah;
- "Fitzroy Crossing area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of three miles from the principal post office at Fitzroy Crossing;
- "Hall's Creek area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Hall's Creek;
- "Turkey Creek area" means that portion of the State comprised in an imaginary circle having a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office at Turkey Creek.

Sales by Millers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which plain flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal may be sold by millers to be—

- (a) when sold for delivery in the Metropolitan Area and delivered on buyer's premises or delivered to buyers elsewhere than on buyer's premises in bags or other containers of approximately 150 lb. weight—£21 9s. per short ton;
- (b) when sold for delivery elsewhere than in the Metropolitan Area and delivered in bags or other containers of approximately 150 lb. weight to buyers at mill door, at mill store or mill siding or railway station, or to buyers on buyer's premises at Rockingham and Spearwood—the appropriate price as specified in the First Schedule to this Order:

Provided that except for sales ex mill door these prices shall apply only for sales in truck lots of 8 long tons;

- (c) when sold for delivery and delivered in less than truck lots of 8 long tons at any railway station or siding other than the mill siding in bags or other containers of approximately 150 lb. weight—the price specified in the First Schedule to this Order, for the sale of flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal at the mill siding nearest to the purchaser's railway station or siding, plus rail freight chargeable for the transportation of the flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal from the mill siding nearest to the purchaser's railway station or siding;
- (d) when sold for loading on ship at Fremantle or Geraldton and for delivery at any North-Western port in bags or other containers of approximately 150 lb. weight the price at Fremantle or Geraldton, as the case may be, in accordance with the prices specified in the First Schedule to this Order for deliveries at Fremantle or Geraldton (as the case may be), plus loading charges actually incurred at Fremantle or Geraldton, as the case may be, plus freight payable on the consignment;
- (e) when sold for delivery in lots of less than one short ton—the price specified in the First Schedule to this Order, plus—
 - (i) a margin at the rate of 10s. per short ton for sales of lots of less than one short ton, but of not less than ½ ton;
 - (ii) a margin at the rate of 15s. per short ton for sales of lots of less than $\frac{1}{2}$ short ton;
- (f) when sold for delivery in the class or kind of containers specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order, the prices specified in the First Schedule to this Order, plus the margin thereon at the rate specified opposite each such class or kind of container, respectively, in the second, third or fourth columns of the Second Schedule to this Order.

Provided that the prices specified in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be subject to 5s. per short ton discount for cash. Wholesale Sales-other than by Millers.

5. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which plain flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal may be sold by wholesale, other than by a miller, to be—

- (a) for quantities of one short ton or more the prices specified in the First Schedule to this Order;
- (b) for quantities of less than one short ton the price paid or payable for such flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal by the wholesale seller, plus transportation charges (if any) actually incurred by the wholesale seller in placing such flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal in the wholesale seller's store, plus the margins specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.

Sales by Retail.

6. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which plain flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal may be sold by retail to be—

- (a) in places South of the 26th parallel of South latitude—
 - (i) for sales in bags—the maximum price fixed by the provisions of paragraphs 4 or 5 of this Order, as the case may be, for the sale of those goods, plus transportation charges (if any) actually incurred by the retail seller in placing such flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal in the retail seller's store, plus the margin specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order;
 - (ii) for sales in quantities less than 25 lb.—the prices specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) in places North of the 26th parallel of South latitude—
 - (i) for sales in bags—the maximum price free on board ship at Fremantle or Geraldton, as the case may be, of such flour, whole wheat-meal or standard wheatmeal as fixed in subparagraph (d) of paragraph 4 of this Order, plus the margin specified for the respective areas in the Fifth Schedule to this Order;
 - (ii) for sales in quantities less than 25lb.
 —the prices specified for the respective areas in the Fifth Schedule to this Order.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, where a maximum price is fixed by notice in writing to any person in relation to any flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal, the maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which such flour, whole wheatmeal and standard wheatmeal may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
