Prices Control Order No. 641.

Whole Wheat.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 641.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 533 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“bushel” means 60 lb.;

“ton” means 2,240 lb.;

“by wholesale” means, in relation to any sale of whole wheat, that such whole wheat is sold to the purchaser for the purposes of resale and “wholesale” shall also be deemed to apply to sales to users who purchase at each delivery a total of not less than one ton;

“by retail” means, in relation to any sale of whole wheat, that such sale is not a sale by wholesale as defined in the preceding clause of this paragraph;

“nearest railway station or siding” mean the railway station or siding nearest the whole-sale seller's store;

“Perth Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Western Australia comprised within a radius of 12 miles from the General Post Office at Perth;

"retail seller's cost-into-store" means the sum of—

- (a) the price paid or payable for that wheat;
- (b) cost of transport from the point of delivery to the retail seller to the retail seller's store, and
- (c) where the wheat is purchased by the retail seller in bulk, 3d. per bushel for bagging, plus the maximum price fixed for the bag in which the whole wheat is packed.

Sales by Wholesale.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which whole wheat may be sold by wholesale to be—

- (a) in respect of sales within the Perth Metropolitan Area, the price specified in the First Schedule to this Order;
- (b) in respect of sales outside the Perth Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the price paid or payable for the whole wheat ex rail truck at the nearest railway station or siding;
 - (ii) the cost of cartage from rail to the wholesale seller's store;
 - (iii) where whole wheat is purchased in bulk, the maximum price fixed for the bag in which it is packed; and
 - (iv) a margin at the rate of—
 - (i) nine pence per bushel for sales ex store;
 - (ii) twelve pence per bushel delivered free on rail, free on wharf, or to purchaser's premises;
 - (iii) fifteen pence per bushel delivered free on board.

Sales by Retail.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which whole wheat may be sold by retail to be the retail seller's cost-into-store plus the margin as set out in the Second Schedule to this Order, according to the quantity sold and the point of delivery.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which whole wheat specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which ice of any weight specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail by any person in the Perth Metropolitan Area to be the price set out opposite such weight in the second column of the Schedule.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any ice specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to such person.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 644.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 547, as amended by Prices Control Order No. 598, is hereby revoked.

Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order and the Schedules thereto, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Perth Metropolitan Area” means all that area of the State of Western Australia comprised within a radius of 25 miles from the General Post Office at Perth;

“cash sale” means, in relation to any sale of bread or Vienna bread, any sale within any period of 16 days where payment for all bread or Vienna bread sold within the said period is made within that period;

“booked sale” means, in relation to any sale of bread or Vienna bread, that such sale is not a cash sale as defined in this paragraph;

“bread” means white bread, wholemeal bread, whole wheatmeal bread, and brown bread;

“1 lb. loaf” means a No. 1 loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“2 lb. loaf” means a No. 2 loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“Vienna bread” or “Vienna rolls” means Vienna bread or Vienna rolls within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“Vienna ½ lb. loaf” means a No. 1 Vienna loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“Vienna 1 lb. loaf” means a No. 2 Vienna loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1904-1947.

Maximum Prices.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any bread rolls, Vienna bread and Vienna rolls may be sold in the Perth Metropolitan Area and Rottnest Island to be—

(a) in respect of sales of bread and Vienna bread in the Perth Metropolitan Area—the price specified in the First Schedule to this Order;

(b) in respect of sales of bread and Vienna bread in Rottnest Island—the price specified in the Second Schedule to this Order;

(c) in respect of sales of bread rolls and Vienna rolls in the Perth Metropolitan Area and in Rottnest Island—the price specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.

Provided that where 1 lb. loaves of bread other than Vienna bread are sold by retail to the same purchaser by cash sale to the extent that the total number sold is two or a multiple of two, two loaves of bread shall for the purposes of this Order be deemed to be a 2 lb. loaf.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which bread, Vienna bread, bread rolls and Vienna rolls specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold in the Perth Metropolitan Area and in Rottnest Island by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

“booked sale” means, in relation to any sale of bread or Vienna bread, that such sale is not a cash sale as defined in this paragraph;

“bread” means white bread, wholemeal bread, whole wheatmeal bread and brown bread;

“1 lb loaf” means a No. 1 loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“2 lb. loaf” means a No. 2 loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“Vienna bread” or “Vienna rolls” means Vienna bread or Vienna rolls within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

of Western Australia.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 647.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 546, as amended by Prices Control Order No. 597, is hereby revoked.

Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order and the Schedules thereto, unless the contrary intention appears—

“South-West Land Division” means the South-West Land Division of the State of Western Australia, as defined in the Land Act, 1933-1946, of that State, but excluding from such South-West Land Division (as so defined) that portion thereof hereinafter defined as the “Perth Metropolitan Area”;

“Perth Metropolitan Area” means all that area of the State of Western Australia comprised within a radius of 25 miles from the General Post Office at Perth;

“cash sale” means, in relation to any sale of bread or Vienna bread, any sale within any period of 16 days where payment for all bread or Vienna bread sold within the said period is made within that period;

“booked sale” means, in relation to any sale of bread or Vienna bread, that such sale is not a cash sale as defined in this paragraph;

“consumer’s premises” means the premises of the consumer of bread, but does not include the premises of boarding houses, hostels, hotels, hospitals or resellers;

“bread” means white bread, wholemeal bread, whole wheatmeal bread and brown bread;

“1 lb. loaf” means a No. 1 loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“2 lb. loaf” means a No. 2 loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“Vienna bread” or “Vienna rolls” means Vienna bread or Vienna rolls within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“Vienna $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. loaf” means a No. 1 Vienna loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

“Vienna 1 lb. loaf” means a No. 2 Vienna loaf within the meaning of the Bread Act, 1903-1947;

Maximum Prices.

4. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which bread and bread rolls, Vienna bread and Vienna rolls may be sold in the South-West Land Division to be—

- (a) (i) in respect of sales of bread and Vienna bread within the boundaries of those townsites (other than Ravensthorpe) in which a bakery is established and operating and where delivery is made to consumer’s premises, the prices set out in the First Schedule to this Order;
- (ii) in respect of sales of bread and Vienna bread within the boundaries of those townsites (other than Ravensthorpe) in which a bakery is established and operating and where there are no deliveries made to consumer’s premises, the prices set out in the Second Schedule to this Order;

(b) in respect of sales of bread and Vienna bread within the boundaries of the townsite of Ravensthorpe, the prices set out in the Third Schedule to this Order;

(c) in respect of sales of bread and Vienna bread elsewhere in the South-West Land Division—

(aa) in the case of sales by wholesale, the maximum wholesale price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the sale of that description of bread and Vienna bread by wholesale in the townsite whose boundaries are nearest to the place where that bread is delivered, plus—

(i) 3d. per dozen in the case of 1 lb. loaves of bread and $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. loaves of Vienna bread, and 6d. per dozen in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread and 1 lb. loaves of Vienna bread; or

(ii) the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the seller, or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the seller to any other person, in respect of the delivery of that bread and Vienna bread to the purchaser;

(bb) in the case of sales by retail by any person other than a baker, the maximum wholesale price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the sale of that description of bread and Vienna bread by wholesale in the townsite whose boundaries are nearest to the place where that bread and Vienna bread is delivered, plus—

(i) the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the seller; or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the seller to any other person, in respect of the delivery of that bread and Vienna bread to the purchaser;

(ii) a margin of one penny per loaf in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread, $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. and 1 lb. loaves of Vienna bread and a margin of one half-penny in the case of 1 lb. loaves of bread;

(cc) in the case of sales by retail by a baker, the maximum retail price specified in the First Schedule to this Order for the sale of that description of bread and Vienna bread, plus—

one farthing per loaf in the case of 1 lb. loaves of bread and $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. loaves of Vienna bread, and one half-penny per loaf in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread and 1 lb. loaves of Vienna bread;
