PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 658.

Ales, Lagers and Stouts—Carnamah Areas.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 658.

2. Prices Control Order No. 581 is hereby amended—

by deleting from the words and figures appearing under the sub-heading "Bottled Western Australian Stout"—the following words and figures—

"Per bottle 2 10"

and inserting in their stead the following words and figures—

"Per bottle 2 11"

PRICE CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 659.

Bulk Honey.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 659.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 363 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

"bulk honey" means honey sold in containers containing more than 14 pounds weight of honey.

"Perth Metropolitan Area" means all that area comprised within a radius of 12 miles from the General Post Office, Perth.

"cost of transport" means cost of transport by rail (or if rail transport is not available, any other service which is available) but does not include any cost of transport which is not recorded on an invoice delivered by the seller;

"point of delivery" means in relation to the sale of honey by any person the place at which liability for payment of transport charges in conveying that honey to the purchaser's place of business passed to the purchaser from the person from whom such honey was purchased.

Sales to Wholesale Sellers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bulk honey may be sold by any person to a wholesale seller to be—

(a) where delivery is made in the Perth Metropolitan Area— 93s. 4d. per cwt.;

(b) where delivery is made outside the Perth Metropolitan Area—93s. 4d. per cwt. less the cost of transport that would be incurred in transporting the honey from the seller's premises to the Perth Metropolitan Area, plus the cost of transport actually incurred and properly attributable to conveying the honey from such premises to the point of delivery to the purchaser.

Sales by Wholesale.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bulk honey may be sold by any person by wholesale to be—

- (a) where delivery is made in the Perth Metropolitan Area—113s. 2d. per cwt.;
- (b) where delivery is made outside the Perth Metropolitan Area, the sum of the following:—
 - (i) The price paid or payable by the wholesale seller.
 - (ii) The cost of transport actually incurred in and properly attributable to conveying the honey from the point of delivery to the wholesale seller to the point of delivery by the wholesale seller.

(iii) Margin at the rate of 19s. 10d. per cwt.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which bulk honey specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to such person.
