Prices Control Order No. 663.

Cooked Meats and Smallgoods.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

- 1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 663.
- 2. Prices Control Order No. 614 is hereby amended—
 - (a) by omitting the First Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the First Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) by omitting the Second Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the Second Schedule to this Order;
 - (c) by omitting the Third Schedule thereto and inserting in its stead the Third Schedule to this Order.
