PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 736.

Bran, Pollard, Flaky Bran, Ground Wheat,

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 736.

2. Prices Control Order No. 674 is hereby amended by omitting from the First Schedule thereto the figures "22 7 9" appearing in the Second Column opposite the word "Meekatharra" appearing in the First Column and inserting in their stead the figures "23 7 9."

PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 737.

Sugar—Sales by Wholesale.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 737.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 524 is hereby revoked.

Maximum Wholesale Prices.

3. I fix and declare the maximum price at which sugar of the kinds or grades specified in the first column of the First and Second Schedules to this Order may be sold by any person by wholesale to be—

(a) in respect of any sale of a quantity of 10 cwt. or more—consisting of all or any of those kinds or grades—

(i) where payment is made by cash with order—the price specified in the second or third columns of the First Schedule, according to the quantity sold;

(ii) where payment is made other than by cash with order—the price specified in the fourth or fifth columns of that Schedule, according to the quantity sold—

(a) less, in any case where payment is made within seven days from the date of supplier's invoice, a discount of 3 per centum; or

(b) less, in any case where payment is made within 30 days from date of supplier's invoice, a discount of 2½ per centum;

(b) in respect of sales of quantities of less than 10 cwt.—consisting of all or any of those kinds or grades—

(i) where payment is made by cash with order—the price specified in the second column of the Second Schedule to this Order, less 3 per centum thereof;

(ii) where payment is made other than by cash with order—the price specified in the second column of the Second Schedule to this Order—

(a) less, in any case where payment is made within seven days from the date of supplier's invoice, a discount of 3 per centum; or

(b) less, in any case where payment is made within 30 days from the date of supplier's invoice, a discount of 2½ per centum.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

4. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any sugar, a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order and which is specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 738.

Retail Prices of Sugar—Northern Areas.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 738.

Definitions and Interpretations.

2. In this Order and the Schedule thereto, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Carnarvon area,” “Onslow area,” “Port Hedland area,” “Broome area,” “Yampi area,” “Marble Bar area,” “Noonkanbah area,” “Turkey Creek area,” “Hall’s Creek area,” “Fitzroy Crossing area,” “Nullagine area,” and “Wittenoom Gorge area” mean in each case all of that area comprised within a radius of three miles from the principal post office at each of the places specified;

“Peak Hill area” means all that area comprised within a radius of three miles from the centre of the townsite of Peak Hill;

“Derby area” and “Wyndham area” mean in each case all that area comprised within a radius of 12 miles from the principal post office at each of the places specified;

“Roy Hill area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 10 miles from the centre of De Grey Location No. 5, Roy Hill;

“Roebourne area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 10 miles from the principal post office at Roebourne.

Sales by Retail.

3. I fix and declare the maximum price at which sugar of any of the kinds or grades specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail by any person whose place of business is situated within any of the areas set forth in paragraph 2 of this Order, to be the price specified for that kind or grade of sugar in the second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth or seventh column of the Schedule in respect of the area in which the premises of such person are situated.

Exhibition of Price List.

4. Every retailer who sells or has for sale by retail any of the kinds or grades of sugar specified in the Schedule to this Order, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those kinds or grades of sugar.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any sugar, a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order and which is specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
