PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951. Notice-Declaration No. 71.

I, ARTHUR VALENTINE RUTHERFORD ABBOTT, Attorney General and the Minister of the Crown for the time being charged with the administration of the Prices Control Act, 1948-1951, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 14 of the said Act and the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, do hereby revoke the declarations made under the said Act and Regulations specified in the Schedule to this Declaration No. 71 and published in the *Government Gazette* on the dates set forth in the Schedule in the case of each Declaration.

## PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951. Notice-Declaration No. 72.

I, ARTHUR VALENTINE RUTHERFORD ABBOTT, Attorney General and the Minister of the Crown for the time being charged with the administration of the Prices Control Act, 1948-1951, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 14 of the said Act and the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, do hereby declare the goods specified in the Schedule to this Declaration No. 72 to be declared goods for the purposes of the said Act and Regulations.

Eggs in shell.

Fats, edible, other than tallow and Copha. Fish, other than canned fish.

Flour, wheaten, wheatmeal and self-raising. Fruits, canned or preserved, excepting crystallised fruits.

Golden Syrup, molasses and treacle.

Honey.

Infants' and invalids' foods including Bournvita, Milo and Ovaltine.

Jams. Jellies, other than jelly crystals, jelly powders and calves-foot jelly.

- Margarine.

Matches, other than book matches when used as an advertising medium.

Meals, served in any boarding-house, lodging-house, guest-house or hostel.

Meat meals and bone meals, other than whale meat meal.

Prepared stock and poultry foods.

Meat, fresh, chilled or frozen, viz.---

Beef and mutton;

Offal meat, other than pig offal meat; Sausage meat.

Meats, cooked, and delicatessen smallgoods, viz.---Pork sausages;

- Beef sausages;

- Corned beef;
- Pressed beef; Ox tongue.

Milk, condensed.

Milk, dried or in powder form.

Milk, malted.

Oatmeal, fiaked oats and rolled oats. Onions.

Potatoes. Rice, including ground rice. Salt. Sausage casings. Soap, toilet or laundry, and soap extracts, fiakes and powders. Soap substitutes and compounded detergents for washing and cleansing purposes. Starch. Sugar, of all kinds. Tea. Tomato sauce. Vegetables, fresh, in the control or possession of persons other than the grower, viz.— Beans. Beetroot. Cabbage. Carrots. Caulifiowers. Celery. Cucumbers. Lettuce. Marrows. Parsnips. Peas. Pumpkins. Rhubarb. Silver beet. Sweed turnip. Sweet potatoes. Turnips, white. Wheat and ground wheat. Yeast. Liquors and Tobacco. Ale, beer, larger, porter, stout, or any mixture thereof. Any of the following, or any mixture thereof, with aerated water and/or cordials-Ale; Beer; Larger; Porter; Stout. Tobacco, manufactured. Cigarettes, cigarette paper and papers. Building Materials. Cement bricks and cement building blocks. Cement pipes. Fibro-cement sheets, mouldings, cornices and cover battens. Limestone and standstone. Manufactures of concrete for building and constructional purposes. Portland cement. Roofing sheets and tiles, other than terra-cotta tiles. Sheet metal products used for building and roofing purposes, including the following-Gutter, ridging and valley, downpipe, vent pipe, gutter fittings, crimped bends, rainwater heads, shoes and elbows for downpipe, ridge roll, edge roll and barge roll, tallboys, cowls, chinaman's hats and astragals. Metals, Raw and Processed. Iron and steel sheet, including tin mill, tinned and galvanised. Non-ferrous metals, in primary or fabricated mill forms, such as lumps, slabs, ingots, sheet, strip, rod, wire, tube, angles or other drawn or extruded forms, castings or powder, viz.-Copper. Lead. Scrap copper and lead.

Tin, zinc and spelter.

Non-ferrous alloys, in primary or fabricated mill forms, such as lumps, slabs, ingots, sheet, strip, rod, wire, tube, angles or other drawn or extruded forms, castings or powders and scrap. Iron and steel tubes, pipes and fittings.

Hides, Leather and Rubber. Belting of leather, rubber, canvas or composition. Footwear manufactured parts, viz.-Soles, heels, and rubber pads, uppers and all component parts, materials and aids to manufacture used in the manu-facture of footwear of all descriptions, including slipper forms and piecegoods and rubber soling and heeling materials in any form including "Kromhyd" "Tufhide" and similar materials and substitutes therefor, including "Neolite". Hides and skins-cattle, yearling and calf. Hose, rubber or plastic. Latex. Leather. Tyres and tubes, rubber. Tyre rubber. Packages and Containers. Calico bags. Cans, cannisters and tins. Cartons and cardboard boxes. Drums. Metal kegs and casks. Paper bags. Miscellaneous. Books, school exercise and the like. Coal. Coke. Firewood. Footwear, other than footwear made for the personal use and to the individual measurements of a customer. Greases. Oils, mechanical and lubricating. Perambulators and baby carriages. Petroleum and shale products, excluding aviation gasoline. Power alcohol. Pyrites. Rope, cordage and twine, including binder twine. Superphosphate. Tyre cord and tyre fabric. (The subheadings shown in the above Schedule are to facilitate reference to goods which are the subject of this Declaration. They shall not be read or construed as limiting or defining the scope of any of the items under the subheadings or of the goods included in such items.) PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951. ## Schedule.

- All services supplied in the manufacture, partial manufacture or repair of footwear of all descriptions, including sole-sewing, stuff-cutting, upper sewing and shanking.
- The retreading and recapping of motor tyres.
- Carting, hauling and delivery of goods.
- Services involving the removal of furniture.
- Boarding-house, lodging-house, guest-house and hostel services.
- All rights under agreement for the provision of lodging other than in an hotel.
- Any benefit under a contract of work and labour, or of work and labour and supply of materials, in relation to—
  - (a) laying or construction of foundations for dwelling-houses;
    - (b) tiling of roofs.
