PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951.

Prices Control Order No. 786.

Motor Spirit.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 786.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 627, in so far as it relates to sales of motor spirit in any of the towns or places specified in the Schedule to this Order, is hereby revoked.

Definition.

3. In this Order and the Schedule thereto, unless the contrary intention appears—

“motor spirit” means a liquid petroleum or shale product normally marketed for use as fuel in internal combustion engines with spark ignition, excluding power kerosene and fuels blended with alcohol.

Sales by Retail.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which motor spirit may be sold by any person by retail in the towns and places specified in the Schedule to this Order, to be the price specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite the name of the town or place specified in the first column of that Schedule.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order—

- (i) I declare the maximum price at which any motor spirit specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person;
- (ii) where any notice in writing fixing the maximum price of any motor spirit was given in pursuance of any Order, which was by virtue of the Prices Control Act, 1948-1951, in force immediately prior to the commencement of this Order, that notice in writing shall be deemed to have been given under this Order and shall continue in full force and effect.
