Prices Control Order No. 837.

Bread—South-West Land Division of Western Australia.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 837.

2. Prices Control Order No. 834 is hereby amended—

- (i) by omitting from paragraph 4 thereof subparagraph (d) and inserting in its stead the following:—
 - (d) in respect of sales of bread elsewhere in the South-West Land Divition—

(aa) in the case of sales by wholesale---

- (i) where delivery is made by a baker to a reseller's premises, 6s. 3d. per dozen in the case of 1 lb. loaves and 12s. 6d. per dozen in the case of 2 lb. loaves; and
- (ii) where bread is placed on rail or with a carrier, the maximum wholesale price fixed by the First or Second Schedules to this Order, as the case may be, plus the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the baker, or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the baker to any other person in respect of the delivery of that bread to the purchaser;

(bb) in the case of sales by retail by any person other than a baker, the wholesale price paid or payable to the baker in the townsite whose boundaries are nearest to the place where that bread is delivered, plus—

- (i) the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the retail seller; or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the retail seller, in respect of the delivery of that bread to the purchaser;
- (ii) a margin of one halfpenny per loaf in the case of 1 lb. loaves and one penny per loaf in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread;
- (cc) in the case of sales by retail—
 (i) where delivery is made by a baker, the maximum retail price specified in the First Schedule to this Order for the sale of that description of bread, plus—

one halfpenny per loaf in the case of 1 lb. loaves of bread and one penny per loaf in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread;

(ii) where bread is placed on rail or with a carrier, the maximum retail price fixed by the First or Second Schedules to this Order as the case may be plus the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the baker, or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the baker to any other person in respect of the delivery of that bread to the purchaser; (ii) by omitting from Part 1 of the First Schedule thereto the words "Brunswick Junction" and "Donnybrook" and by inserting in Part 1 of the Second Schedule the words "Brunswick Junction" immediately after the word "Broomehill" and the word "Donnybrook" immediately after the word "Denmark."

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 838.

2. Prices Control Order No. 833 is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph 4 thereof subparagraph (b) and inserting in its stead the following:—

- (b) In respect of sales of bread elsewhere than in the townsites specified in that Schedule—
 - (bb) in the case of sales by wholesale, the maximum wholesale price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the sale of that bread by wholesale in the townsite whose boundaries are nearest to the place where that bread is delivered, plus—
 - (i) where delivery is made by a baker to a reseller's premises, 3d. per dozen in the case of 1 lb. loaves of bread and 6d. per dozen in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread, or
 - (ii) where bread is placed on rail or with a carrier, the maximum wholesale price fixed by the Schedule to this Order, plus the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the baker, or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the baker to any other person, in respect of the delivery of that bread to the purchaser;

- (c) in the case of sales by retail by any person other than a baker, the wholesale price paid or payable to the baker in the townsite whose boundaries are nearest to the place where that bread is delivered, plus—
 - (i) the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the retail seller; or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the retail seller in respect of the delivery of that bread to the purchaser;
 - (ii) a margin of one half-penny per loaf in the case of 1 lb. loaves and one penny per loaf in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread;
 - (cc) in the case of sales by retail—
 - (i) where delivery is made by a baker, the maximum retail price specified in the Schedule to this Order for the sale of that description of bread, plus
 - one halfpenny per loaf in the case of 1 lb. loaves of bread and one penny per loaf in the case of 2 lb. loaves of bread;
 - (ii) where bread is placed on rail or with a carrier, the maximum retail price fixed by the Schedule to this Order, plus the actual amount of railage (if any) paid or payable by the baker, or the actual amount of delivery charges (if any) paid or payable by the baker to any other person in respect of the delivery of that bread to the purchaser.
