PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948-1951. Prices Control Order No. 841.

Butter.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 841.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 741 is hereby amended by omitting paragraph 7 thereof and inserting in its stead the following:

Maximum Prices—Sales by Retail North of the 26th Parallel of South Latitude.

- 7. I fix and declare the maximum price at which butter may be sold by any person by retail North of the 26th parallel of South latitude to be-
 - (a) in respect of sales by any person whose place of business is situated within the Carnarvon area—4s. $5\frac{1}{2}d$. per lb.;

- (b) in respect of sales by any person whose place of business is situated within the Onslow area, Port Hedland area, Roebourne area or the Broome area-4s. 8½d. per lb.;
- (c) in respect of sales by any person whose place of business is situated within the Derby area, Wyndham area or the Yampi area—5s. per lb.;
- (d) in respect of sales by any person whose place of business is situated within the Marble Bar area—5s. 4d. per lb.:
- (e) in respect of sales by any person whose place of business is situated within place of business is situated within the Fitzroy Crossing area, Noonkan-bah area, Nullagine area, Turkey Creek area, or the Wittenoom Gorge area—5s. 5d. per lb.;
- (f) in respect of sales by any person whose place of business is situated within the Peak Hill area, Roy Hill area or the Hall's Creek area-5s. 6d. per lb.
