HEALTH ACT, 1911-1952.

Section 293A.

Notice Requiring Persons to Submit to X-Ray Examination.

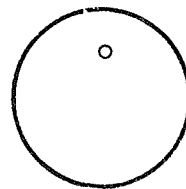
