Land Act, 1933-1953.
ORDER IN COUNCIL.
Corr. No. 1882/54.
WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 19331953, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order; and whereas it is deemed expedient that reserve No. 23974 (Broome Lot 620) should vest in and be held by the Broome Road Board in trust for the purpose of a Fuel Depot: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Broome Road Board in trust for the purpose aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by section 37 of the said Act.

Probate (Non-contentious Costs) Rules, 1949.
The Honourable Sir John Patrick Dwyer, K.C.M.G.. Chief Justice of Western Australia, the Honourable Albert Asher Wolff, the Honourable James Leonard Walker, the Honourable Lawrence Walter Jackson and the Honourable John Evenden Virtue, Puisne Judges of the Supreme Court of Western Australia, do hereby, in pursuance of the powers contained in the Supreme Court Act, 19351950, and in the Administration Act, 1903-1953, and of every other power them in this behalf enabling, amend The Probate (Non-contentious Costs) Rules, 1949, as follows:-

1. Rule 3 is amended by deleting the figures and letters " 2 s .6 d ." in the second last line and substituting therefor the figures and letters " 4 s . 6d."
2. Rule 6 is deleted and the following substi-tuted:-

Any additional charges shall be governed by the scale from time to time promulgated by the Law society of Western Australia (Incorporated) and approved by the Judges.
