- (d) The laying of approximately 0.8 miles of 12in. nominal diameter reinforced concrete water main

Part VIIIA.

Avertising by Optometrists.

43A. No person, firm or company shall publically advertise or make known that he or any other person is practising or is about to practise optometry or that the firm or company is carrying on as part of its business the practise of optometry or the place or places whereat such person is practising or is about to practise optometry or the firm or company is carrying on business except by the following media and then only in accordance with the terms and conditions hereinafter prescribed:—

- (a) By the display at the place of practise and at the place of business of any country agent of the—
 - (1) business name;

 - (2) type of business;(3) hours of practise;
 - (4) names and approved qualifications of employer and employee optometrists.
- (b) By window and showcase display at the place of practise and/or the place of business of any country agent.
- (c) By direct postal, mail in the form of a personal letter and/or approved business card to own clients. Before any registered optometrist uses the business card a specimen of such card shall be referred to the Board and its ap-proval thereto obtained.
- (d) By press announcements in any newspaper. Any such press announcements shall be limited in size to two inch double column or four inch single

column and shall be printed only in black lettering on white background. And may contain-

- (1) where the advertiser is a firm the names and approved quali-fications of the practising partners:
- (2) name of advertiser;
- (3) type of business;
- (4) names with approved qualifications of registered optometrists employed by the advertiser;
- (5) place of practise:
- (6) hours of practise and telephone number:
- (7) country itineraries where applicable.

No details other than those required or permitted by this rule shall be contained in any advertisement.

- (e) Stationery.—The stationery heading shall be limited to and may contain the following:-
 - (1) Business name and type of business.
 - (2) In the case of a firm the names of the partners and their approved qualifications.
 - (3) Names and approved qualifica-tions of all optometrists em-ployed in the business.
 - (4) Place of practise and place of business of any country agent.
 - (5) Hours of practise and telephone number.

Paragraph (e) of these rules shall not come into operation until six months after the publication of the rules in the Gazette.

In this rule "approved qualifications" means qualifications acceptable to the Board pursuant to the Act and such other qualifications as may be approved by the Board from time to time for the purpose of this rule.

- A registered optometrist commencing practise on his own account or resuming practise after having abandoned practise for the continuous period of six months or more may be granted permission by the Board to advertise in such special manner and for such period not exceeding one year as may be specified in the consent. Application to the Board for such permission shall be in writing supported by such evidence as the Board may require and the decision of the Board on any such application shall be final.
