Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954. Reserve for Natives.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT, CHARLES HENRY GAIRDNER, Governor. [L.S.]

By His Excellency Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Henry Gairdner, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by section 11 of the Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954 (reprinted), it is provided that the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to declare any Crown lands to be a Reserve for Natives; and whereas it is deemed desirable that a Reserve for Natives be declared in the Mount Magnet District: Now, therefore, I, the said Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council do hereby declare the area more particularly described in the Schedule hereto to be a Reserve for Natives.

Schedule.

Mount Magnet District. Reserve 24431 (Natives).

All that portion of land being lot No. 368 and comprising eight acres.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State at Perth, this 23rd day of May, 1956.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber at Perth on the 6th day of June, 1956, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

C.S.D. 160/56.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951, that the municipal and road districts mentioned in the Second Schedule to

the Act are, for the purposes of the Act, constituted fire districts by the names as in the said Schedule stated, and that the Governor may, by Order in Council—

- (a) constitute the district of any other local authority a fire district, assign a name to any such fire district, and include the same in Part II or Part III or Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act;
- (b) excise from any fire district any specified portion thereof, and thereupon such portion shall, for the purposes of the Act, be no longer included in or be part of such district:

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth by this Order—

- (1) constitute the Kojonup Road District a fire district; assign the name of Konjonup Fire District to the fire district and order and direct that the Kojonup Road District be, and the same is, hereby included in Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act; and
- (2) excise from the Kojonup Fire District so constituted all the land contained within the boundaries of the Kojonup Road District with the exception of all that portion of land bounded by lines starting at the North-Eastern corner of Kojonup Location 30 and extending East-South-Easterly to and along the North-Eastern boundaries of Kojonup Town Lots P2, P5 and P11; thence Southerly along the Western side of Albany Highway (road No. 6963); thence Easterly to and along the Northern side of Katanning Road (road No. 350); thence Northerly along the Western side of Forsythe Road; thence Easterly to and along the Northern side of Flanagan Road and onwards to the Eastern side of Dearle Road; thence Southerly along that side and the Eastern boundary of town lot 92 and onwards to the Northern side of Broomehill Road (road No. 351); thence West-North-Westerly along that side to the South-Eastern corner of town lot 144; thence South-Easterly to a point on the

South-Western side of the Kojonup-Katanning Railway Reserve situate North of the junction of the Southern side of Crescent Road (road No. 10460) and the North-Eastern side of Hallam Road; thence generally South-Easterly along that side of that railway reserve for a distance of about 25 chains 50 links to the left bank of a tributary of Kojonup Brook; thence generally Southerly, upwards, along that bank; thence Westerly along the Northern boundary of Kojonup Location 778; thence South-Easterly along the North-Eastern side of Albany Highway aforesaid to a point situate in prolongation Easterly of the Southern boundary of location 1086; thence Westerly and Northerly to and along the Southern and Western boundaries of that location 147; thence generally West-North-Westerly along the Southern side of Blackwood Road; and thence generally North-North-Easterly to and along the Western side of Soldier Road (road No. 8917) to the starting point. (Public Plan Kojonup Townsite.)

Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951, that the municipal and road districts mentioned in the Second Schedule to the Act are, for the purposes of the Act, constituted fire districts by the names as in the said Schedule stated, and that the Governor may, by Order in Council—

- (a) constitute the district of any other local authority a fire district, assign a name to any such fire district, and include the same in Part II or Part III or Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act;
- (b) excise from any fire district any specified portion thereof, and that thereupon such portion shall, for the purposes of the Act, be no longer included in or be part of such district:

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth by this Order—

- (1) constitute the Drakesbrook Road District a fire district; assign the name of Waroona Fire District to the fire district so constituted and order and direct that the Drakesbrook Road District be, and the same is hereby included in Part IV of the Second Schedule to the Act; and
- (2) excise from the Waroona Fire District so constituted all the land contained within the boundaries of the Drakesbrook Road District with the exception of all that portion of land bounded by lines starting at the North-Eastern corner of Waroona Suburban Lot 36 and extending generally Easterly to and along the Southern boundary of suburban lot 39 and onwards to and along the Northern sides of McDowell Street and the Southern boundaries of Waroona Town Lots 261 to 265 inclusive and 317 and again onwards to the Eastern side of Hill Street; thence Southerly along that side and onwards to the Southern side of McLarty Street; thence Westerly along that side; thence generally South-South-Easterly along the Eastern sides of South Western Highway (road No. 41): thence generally Westerly downwards along the right bank of Drake's Brook; thence generally North-North-Westerly along the Eastern sides of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence Westerly along part of the Northern boundary of Murray Location 26; thence Northerly along the Eastern boundary of location 135 and onwards to a point situate

in prolongation Easterly of the Northern boundary of that location; thence Easterly along that prolongation to a point situate in prolongation Southerly of the Easternmost boundary of Harvey Agricultural Area Lot 44; and thence generally North-North-Westerly to and along the Eastern boundaries of agricultural area lots 44 to 50 inclusive and Waroona Suburban Lots 37 and 36 aforesaid to the starting point. (Public Plans Waroona Townsite and 383A/40.)
