C.S.D. 308/56.

WHEREAS by section 3 of the Inebriates Act, 1912-1919, it is provided that the Governor may establish institutions for the reception, care, control and treatment of inebriates, and it is also provided by the said section that an institution may, if the Governor thinks fit, be established by setting apart some portion of an existing hospital of whatever kind for the purpose of the Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Inebriates Act, 1912-1919, and of all powers him in this behalf enabling, does hereby establish such rooms of the hospital for the insane known as Greenplace Mental Hospital, as are selected and set apart for the purpose by the Inspector General of institutions for inebriates as an institution for the reception, care, control and treatment of inebriates.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 165 of the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-1954, that the Governor may from time to time by Proclamation exempt any portion of the State from the operation of the Act, or any Part thereof: Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, do by this Proclamation exempt that portion of the State which is comprised within the limits of the Zoological and Acclimatisation Gardens at South Perth established by the Zoological Gardens Act, 1898, and described in the Schedule to that Act from the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-1954, except the provisions relating to Industrial Awards and agreements and to the duties of Industrial inspectors.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber at Perth, on the 18th day of September, 1956, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Water Boards Act, 1904-1951.

Lake Seppings Catchment Area.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 944/55.

WHEREAS by section 36 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1951, the Governor may, from time to time, by Order in Council, constitute any portion of the State a water reserve or catchment area, and define the boundaries thereof: Now therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby constitute that portion of the State defined in the schedule hereunder a catchment area and assign the name of "Lake Seppings Catchment Area" thereto.

This Order in Council shall take effect on the 18th day of September, 1956.

Schedule.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting at the North-Western corner of lot 2 of Plantagenet Location 43 (L.T.O. plan 3301) and extending North-Easterly along the North-Western boundaries of lots 2 to 9 inclusive; thence generally South-Easterly along the North-Eastern boundary of the latter lot and onwards to and along the North-Eastern sides of Loftie Street to the South-Western side of Everard Street; thence South-Easterly along the prolongation of that side to the North-Western side of Golf Links Road; thence generally South-Westerly along that side to a point situate in prolongation Easterly of the Southern boundary of lot 123 of Albany Suburban Lot 399 (L.T.O. plan 5724); thence Westerly along that prolongation to the Eastern side of Lake Road; thence Southerly along that side to a point situate in prolongation Easterly of the Southern side of Anzac Road; thence Westerly to and along that side to the North-Western corner of lot 11 of Albany Suburban Lots B4 and B5 (L.T.O. plan 3951); thence generally North-Westerly to and along the Eastern boundary of lot 16 of Albany Suburban Lots B5 and B8 (L.T.O. plan 3951) to the South-Eastern side of Wakefield Crescent; thence generally North-Westerly along the Southern sides of that crescent and onwards to and along the North-Western boundary of lot 111 of Plantagenet Location 44 (L.T.O. diagram 19546)

and again onwards to the Western side of Seymour Street; thence Northerly along that side and onwards to the North-Western side of Collingwood Street; thence North-Easterly along that side to the Southern corner of location 43 aforesaid; and thence northerly along the Western boundary of that location to the starting point, as shown bordered blue on plan P.W.D., W.A. 34925.
