FREMANTLE HARBOUR TRUST ACT, 1902-1954.

Amendment of Regulations.

Ex. Co. No. 1838.

[L.S.]

THE Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners, acting pursuant to section 65 of the Fremantle Harbour Trust Act, 1902-1954, do hereby amend the regulations made by them and published in the Government Gazette on the 17th day of June, 1955, and since further amended by a notice published in the Government Gazette on the 8th day of June, 1956, in the manner mentioned in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

The abovementioned regulations are amended as follows:-

- 1. By deleting paragraph 2 of regulation No. 147, and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:—
 - 2. All rates of handling charges shall be increased or decreased as the case may require by one per centum—
 - (a) for each complete penny variation in the ordinary hourly rate of pay of waterside workers as in operation from the 1st day of November, 1952; and
 - (b) for each complete penny variation in the rate of charge levied as from 4th May, 1954, under the Stevedoring Industry Charge Assessment Act, 1947-1954 (Commonwealth) for every man hour of employment of waterside workers engaged in stevedoring operations and registered under the Stevedoring Industry Act, 1949-1955 (Commonwealth).

Passed by a resolution of the Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners at a meeting of the said Commissioners held on the 9th day of November, 1956.

TRAFFIC ACT, 1919-1955.

Principal Regs. 1. In these regulations the Traffic Regulations, 1954, published in the Government Gazette on the 15th December, 1954, as amended by the regulations amending the same published in the Gazette on the 9th February, 1955; the 1st April, 1955; the 1th May, 1955; the 17th June, 1955; the 9th August, 1955; the 30th September, 1955; the 30th December, 1955; the 24th April, 1956, and the 23rd October, 1956, are referred to as the principal regulations.

Reg. 30 amended. 2. Regulation 30 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the word "motor" in line two.

Reg. 66 amended.

- 3. Regulation 66 of the principal regulations is amended—
 - (a) by substituting for the passage commencing with the word "The" in line one and ending with the word and punctuation "fitted:—" in line four the following passage:—

The provisions of this regulation and of regulation 67 apply in respect of every motor vehicle plying for hire, other than an omnibus, and to which a taxi-meter is fitted, whether fitted at the request of the Minister under the provisions of regulation 65 or not.;

- (b) by adding after paragraph (d) of subregulation (1) a paragraph as follows:—
 - (e) The driver of a passenger vehicle which is equipped with a taximeter shall not use the vehicle for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward if the taximeter is not registering correctly or is out of order or if the seal of the taximeter is broken.;
- (c) by adding before the paragraph designation "(a)" in line five the subregulation designation "(1a)."

- 4. Regulation 228 of the principal regulations is amended by adding after paragraph (g) a paragraph as follows:—
 - (h) ride on a road a bicycle which is so constructed or in such a condition as to be likely to cause an accident or injury to any person or damage to any property.

5. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 337 a new regulation as follows:—

337A. A person shall not at any time

- (e) park a vehicle on any portion of the Western side of Bay View Terrace between the Southern building line of Stirling Highway and any point 110 feet South thereof;
- (f) park a vehicle on any portion of the Northern side of Stirling Highway between the Eastern building line of Bay View Terrace and any point 120 feet East thereof;
- (g) park a vehicle on any portion of the Southern side of Stirling Highway between the Western building line of Bay View Terrace and any point 120 feet West thereof.
- The principal regulations are amended by adding after neg. 339A added. regulation 339 a new regulation as follows:-

339A. Parking of vehicles on the North side of St. Parking Quentin's Avenue is prohibited.

in St Quentin's Avenue.

- 7. Regulation 349 of the principal regulations is amended by substituting for paragraph (d) the following paragraph:—
 - (d) outside the Western Australian Government Railway Road in Workshops, on that portion of the road within and running along the Northern boundary of Reserve 2299, outside linking the Southern end of Helena Street with Kala- Workshops. munda Road,

- (i) on the South side between the Eastern ramp entrance to the foot bridge and any point 540 feet West thereof;
- (ii) on the North side, between a point opposite the Western ramp entrance to the foot bridge and any point 310 feet West thereof.
- The principal regulations are amended by substituting for Reg. 349A regulation 349A the following regulations:substituted.

(1) Between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. Further on any day of the week excluding Saturdays and Sundays or between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays,

parking restrictions in Midland Junction.

exceeding thirty minutes (a) on any portion of Great Northern Highway between Great Eastern Highway and Morrison

a person shall not park a vehicle for a continuous period

(2) A person shall not park a vehicle for a continuous Gordon St. period exceeding thirty minutes on any portion of the Southern side of Gordon Street between Burgess Street and Spring Park Road.

- 349AA. A person shall not at any time park a vehicle (a) on any portion of the West side of Hampden Road between the Northern alignment of Stirling Highway and any point 120 feet North thereof;
 - (b) on any portion of the South side of Stirling Highway between the Western building line of Broadway and any point 120 feet West thereof;
 - on any portion of the East side of Broadway between the Southern building line of Stirling Highway and any point 85 feet South thereof.

Reg. 366B added.

10. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 366A a new regulation as follows:—

Standing and Parking restrictions in Hampden

366B. A person shall not at any time

- (a) stand a vehicle on any portion of the East side of Hampden Road between the Northern alignment of Stirling Highway and any point 140 feet North thereof;
- (b) park a vehicle on any portion of the North side of Stirling Highway between the Eastern alignment of Hampden Road and any point 120 feet East thereof.

Restriction on load on Naval Base Road.

11. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 377A a new subheading and regulation as follows:-

Cockburn Road District.

377AA. A person shall not drive on any portion of Naval Base Road within the Cockburn Road District, a vehicle carrying a load exceeding six tons in weight.

sub-heading and Regs. 383A and 383B added.

12. The principal regulations are amended by adding after regulation 383 a new subheading and regulations as follows:—

Rockingham Road District.

- 383A. (1) A person in charge of any vehicle shall not park the vehicle, or permit it to be parked on any portion of the road known as Esplanade, within the Rockingham Road District, between Val Street and Fisher Street, or between any point 400 feet South-West of Fisher Street and Hymus
- (2) A person in charge of any vehicle shall not park the vehicle or permit it to be parked—
 - (a) on any portion of the road known as Esplanade between any point in line with the South-Western alignment of Fisher Street and any point 400 feet South-West thereof unless it is parked-
 - (i) on the North-Western side, at an angle of 45 degrees from, and as near as practicable, to the kerb; or
 - (ii) on the South-Eastern side, as near as practicable, and parallel, to the kerb;
 - (b) on any portion of the North-Western side of Rockingham Road between Railway Terrace and any point in line with the South-Western alignment of Wanliss Street unless it is parked at an angle of 45 degrees from, and as near as practicable to, the kerb;

Parking restrictions in Esplanade.

- (c) on any portion of the South-Eastern side of Rockingham Road between Flinder's Lane and any point in line with the South-Western align-ment of Wanliss Street, unless it is parked as near as practicable, and parallel, to the kerb;
- (d) between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day of the week excepting Saturdays and Sundays, or between the hours of 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Saturdays, on any portion of the South-Eastern side of Rockingham Road between Railway Terrace and Flinders Lane-

for a continuous period exceeding thirty minutes

unless the vehicle is parked as near as practicable, and parallel, to the kerb;

(e) on any portion of the South-Western or North-Eastern side of Flinders Lane between Rockingham Road and the foreshore unless it is parked at an angle of 45 degrees from, and as near as practicable, to the kerb.

Filnders

383B (1) In this regulation "parking area" means an Parking area defined on the surface of the road known as Railway Terrace, by or under the authority of the Commissioner of Police as an area for the parking of vehicles and which area is so defined and is divided into parking spaces by means of lines not less than two inches wide, of white, yellow or other colour painted or marked on the surface of the road and is so maintained.

- (2) (a) A person shall not stand a vehicle on any portion of the road known as Railway Terrace between Parkin Street and the beach except within a parking area.
- (b) A person who stands a vehicle within a parking area defined on any portion of Railway Terrace between Parkin Street and the beach shall not leave any portion of the vehicle on or over any of the lines by means of which the area is defined or is divided into parking spaces.
