WHEREAS by section 17 of the Courts of Session Act, 1921, the Governor may by proclamation fix the times at which periodical sittings of Courts of Session may be held and also revoke or vary any proclamation made under that section; and whereas by proclamation dated the 12th day of February, 1942, the Thursday following the fourth Monday in January, April, July and October was fixed as the day on which the periodical sittings of the South-West Court of Session at Bunbury shall be held; and whereas the Thursday following the fourth Monday in April, 1957, falls on a public holiday it is desirable to alter the date of that sitting: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby appoint 29th day of April, 1957, as the day on which that sitting that he held shall be held.

# PUBLIC SERVICE OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA. Promotional Examination.
