### GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS ACT, 1904-1955.

#### Schedule.

##### By-laws.

1. By-law 61, made pursuant to the Government Railways Act, 1904, as amended, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 11th April, 1930, and amended by notices published in the *Government Gazette* on the 10th May, 1940, and the 26th September, 1947, is referred to in this by-law as the principal by-law.

2. Item 3—Life Passes, of the principal by-law is amended by substituting the word "twelve" for the word "fifteen" appearing in line 1 of paragraph (g).

## ALBANY HARBOUR BOARD ACT, 1926-1955.

## Albany Harbour Board—Resolution.

C.S.D. 16/53, Ex. Co. No. 355.

THE Albany Harbour Board, constituted under and by virtue of the Albany Harbour Board Act, 1926-1955, doth hereby amend in the manner mentioned in the Schedule hereunder the regulations made under the Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 30th day of March, 1951, and amended from time to time thereafter by notices published in the *Government Gazette*.

## Schedule.

The abovementioned regulations are amended as follows:—

1. By deleting paragraph (1) of regulation No. 181, and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:—

(1) Subject to the approval in writing of the Harbour Master, inflammable liquid in bulk may be discharged in bulk into a tank ashore after sunset provided that the following conditions and such other conditions as may be prescribed by the members in special cases are complied with:—

- (1) Sufficient electric flood lighting of approved type shall be provided to give ample light for all operations.
- (2) Arrangements shall be made by the master of the tank ship to ensure that there will be a sufficient staff of officers and men available at all times to ensure the efficient carrying on of the work, or to remove the vessel, if so required.

Passed by a resolution of the Albany Harbour Board at a duly convened meeting held on the 9th day of January, 1957.

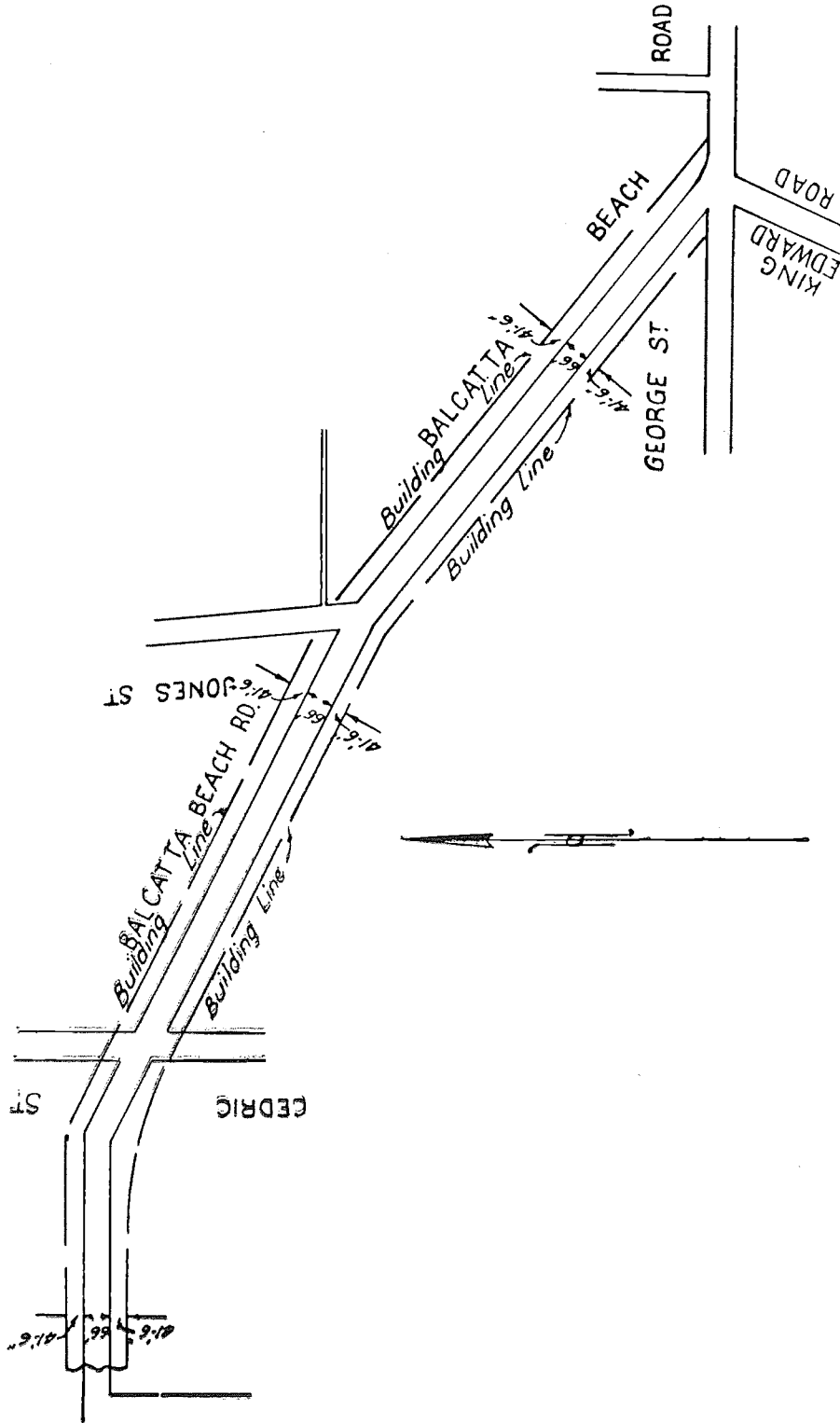
## By-laws Amending By-laws Establishing Building Lines.

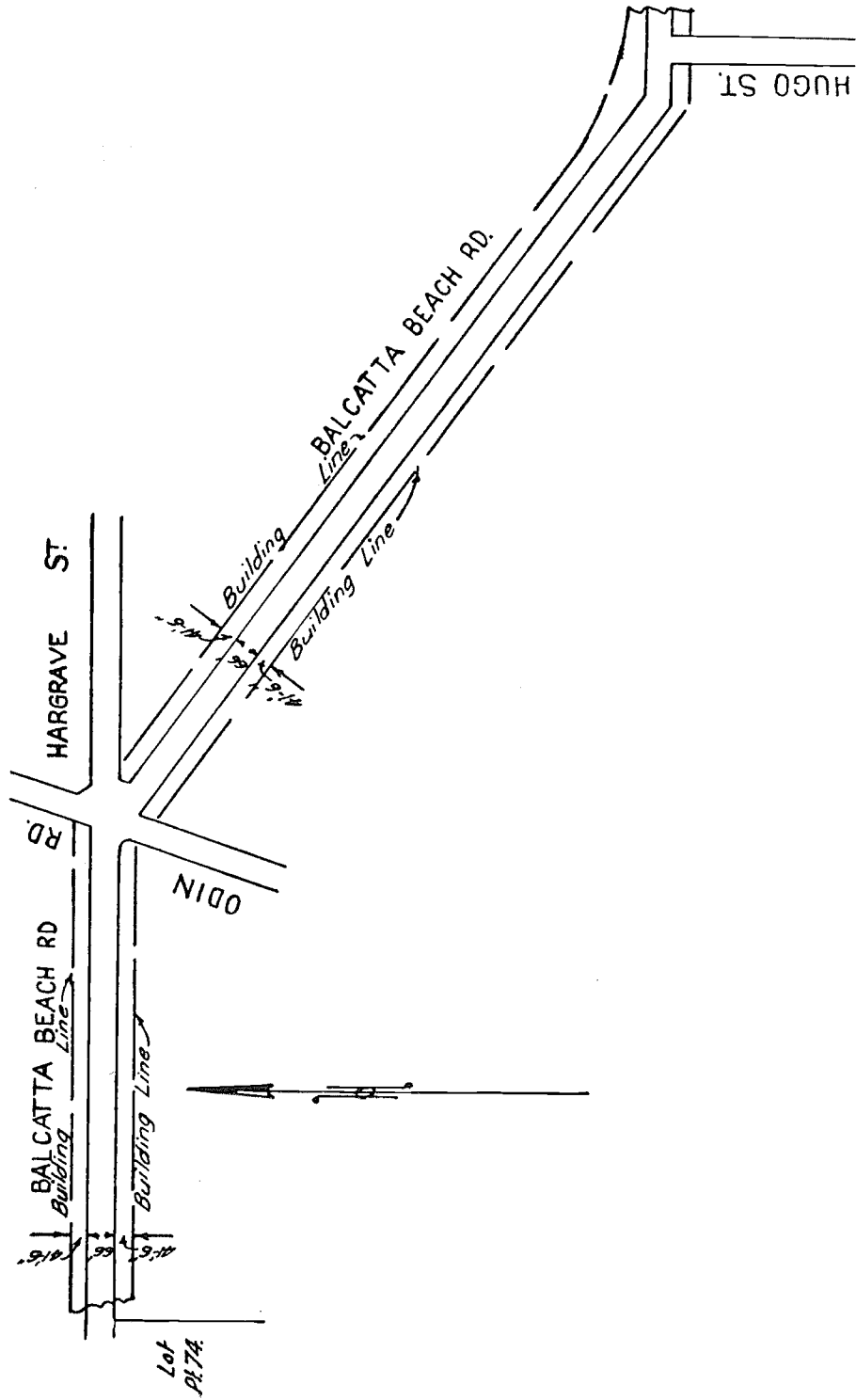

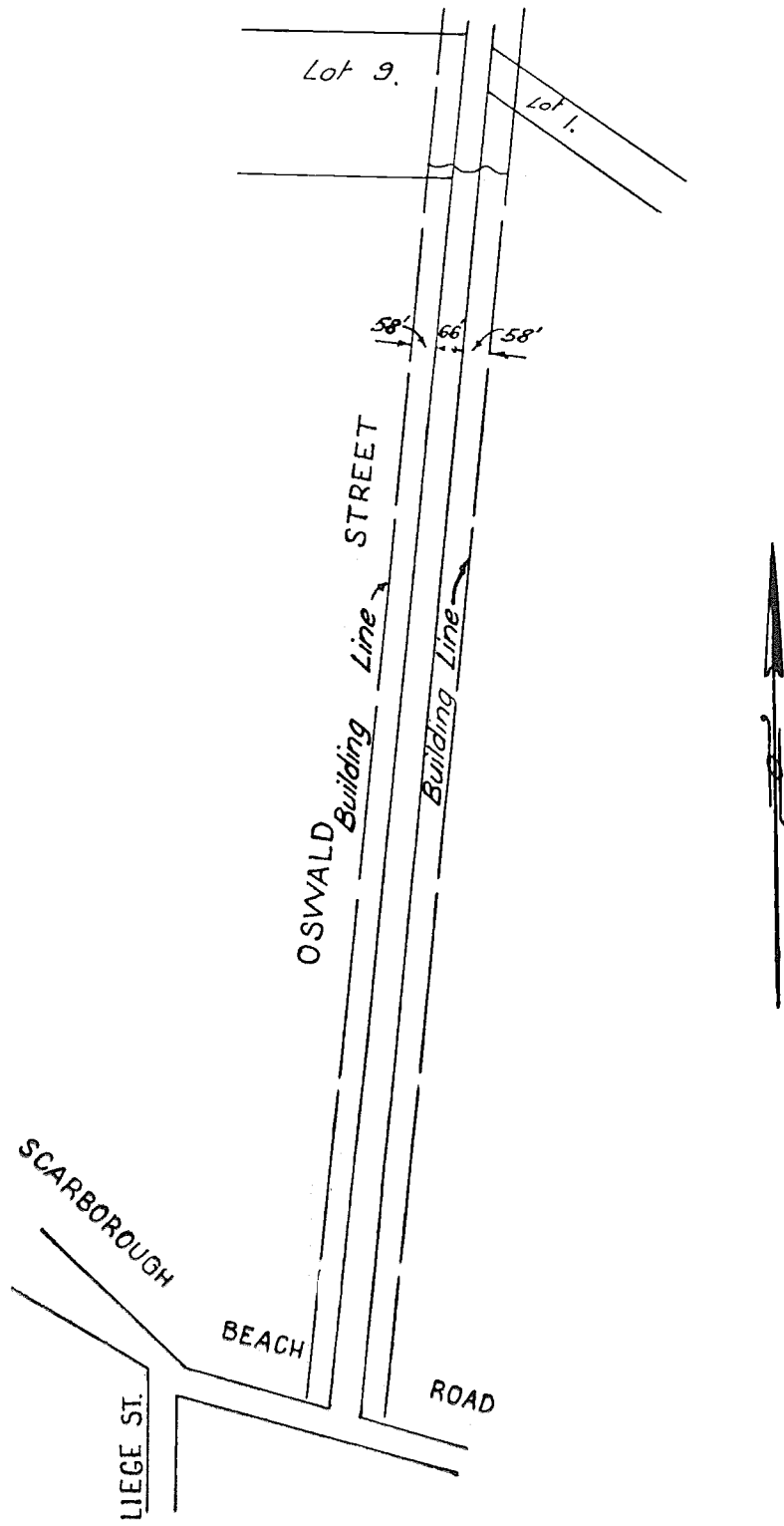

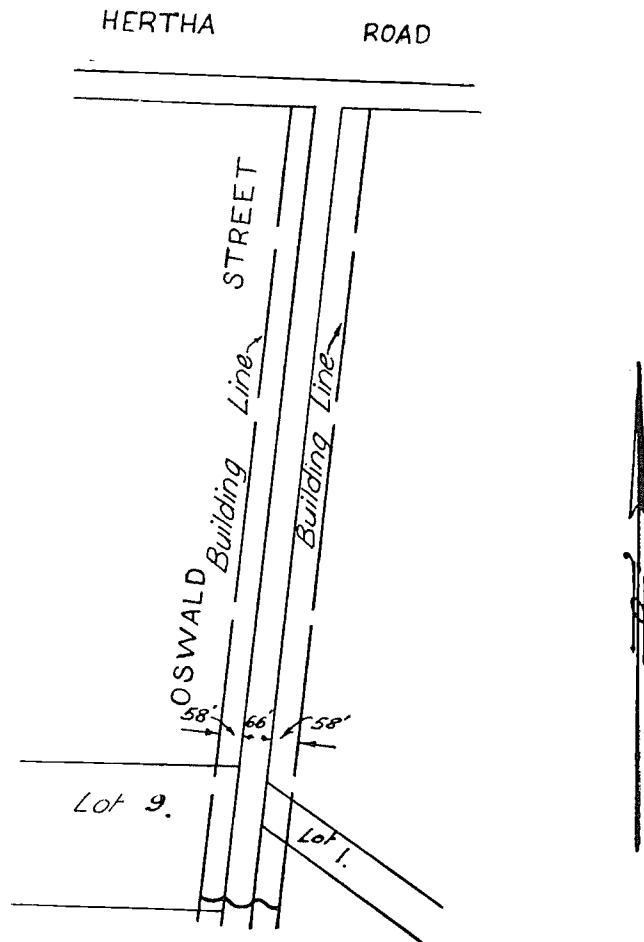
The Schedule to the said by-laws is amended by the addition thereto of the following plans:—
