WHEREAS by section 4A of the Superannuation, Sick, Death, Insurance, Guarantee and Endowment (Local Governing Bodies' Employees) Funds Act, 1947-1950, it is provided *inter alia* that the Governor, by proclamation, may declare any persons to be corporations for the purposes of the provisions of the Act: Now, therefore I, the Governor, do by this Proclamation declare The Fremantle Municipal Transport Board, a body constituted pursuant to the provisions of section 22 of the Fremantle Municipal Tramways and Electric Lighting Act, 1903, to be a corporation for the purposes of the Superannuation, Sick, Death, Insurance, Guarantee and Endowment (Local Governing Bodies' Employees) Funds Act, 1947-1950.
