Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954. Reserve for Natives. PROCLAMATION

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WHEREAS by section 11 of the Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954, it is provided that the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to declare any Crown Lands to be reserves for natives; and whereas it is deemed desirable that a reserve for natives should be declared at Williams: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby declare an area of about 22 acres 2 roods at Williams, more particularly described in the Schedule hereto, to be a reserve for natives.

Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1956.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1956, that it shall be obligatory for every employer to obtain from an incorporated insurance office approved by the Minister a policy of insurance for the full amount of liability to pay compensation under the Act to of liability to pay compensation under the Act to all workers employed by him, but that if an em-ployer proves to the satisfaction of the Minister that such employer has established a fund for insurance against such liability and has deposited at the Treasury securities charged with all pay-ments to become due under such liability, the Gov-ernor may, by Order in Council, exempt such em-ployer from the operation of the said section: and ernor may, by Order in Counten, exempt such an-ployer from the operation of the said section; and whereas Australian Iron & Steel Limited, of Steam-ship Buildings, 168 St. George's Terrace, Perth, being an employer within the meaning of the Act, and as such subject to the section and having made application in accordance with the Act and the regulation made thereunder for exemption from the operation of section 13, has satisfied the Minister that it has established a fund for insurance against its liability to pay compensation under the Act to all workers employed by it, and has deposited at the Treasury a security, to wit, Commonwealth Government Inscribed Stock to the face value of five thousand pounds, bearing interest at the rate of 31 per cent., maturing on 15th September, 1961, charged with all payments by the Company to become due under its liability aforesaid: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Act, doth hereby exempt Australian Iron & Charl instant from the council of acting the Steel Limited from the operation of section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1956, until and including the 25th day of January, 1959.
