ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corres. No. 7792/50.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1956, it is *inter alia*, made lawful for the Governor by Order in Council to direct that any land reserved pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall

be granted in fee simple to any person (as defined in the said section) subject to the condition that the person shall not lease or mortgage the whole or any part of the land without the consent of the Governor and subject to such other conditions and limitations as the Governor shall deem necessary to ensure that the land is used for the purpose for which the land is reserved as aforesaid: and whereas it is deemed expedient that reserve No. 23782 (Boyup Brook Lot 275) should, subject as aforesaid, be granted in fee simple to the Girl Guides Association, Western Australian Branch (Incorporated) to be held in trust for the purpose of a Hall Site (Girl Guides): Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby direct that the before mentioned reserve shall be granted in fee simple to the Girl Guides Association, Western Australian Branch (Incorporated) to be held in trust for the purpose aforesaid, subject to the condition that the land shall not be leased or mortgaged in whole or in part without the consent of the Governor.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1956, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order, and with power of sub-letting, and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corr. No. 6876/47—That reserve 24747 (Plantagenet Location 6261) should vest in and be held by the Albany Road Board in trust for Recreation and Hall Site.

Corr. No. 1964/45*—That reserve 22559 (Brookton Lot 110) should vest in and be held by the Brookton Road Board in trust for the purpose of Recreation (Croquet).

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 1290/55.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works, and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Sewerage.

Fremantle District.

Fremantle Main Sewer—Relaying 3rd Section.

A 30-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe sewer with manholes and other apparatus connected therewith, as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 8130.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 5th day of July, 1957.

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956.

Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1
Mills Street, Bentley, Extension.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 275/57.

WHEREAS by section 7 (a) of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that the Governor may, by Order-in-Council, alter or extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Area, or of any District, or Metropolitan Main Drainage District; and whereas it is desirable that the boundaries of Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 as at present defined should be altered: now therefore I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby extend the boundaries of Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 and declare that the said boundaries, as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. and D.D. W.A. No. 7087, and as described in Order-in-Council of 19th June, 1957, shall be extended in the following manner, by adding the area described in the Schedule hereunder and including it in Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1.

Schedule.

All that portion of land, bounded by lines commencing at a point opposite the Southern boundary of Mills Street, Bentley, and on the centre of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence proceeding Southerly along the centre of the said reserve to a point opposite the Southern boundary of lot 186, Railway Promenade; thence in a Westerly direction across the said Railway Reserve, to and across Railway Promenade, to and along the said boundary, to and along the Southern boundary of the Drain Reserve between Mills Street and Hamilton Street, and Burton and Hamilton Streets, to and across Manning Road to the Western boundary of Chapman Road; thence in a Southerly direction along the said Western boundary to the Southern boundary of lot 4; thence Westerly along the said Southern boundary to the Eastern boundary of lot 7, Fern Road; thence Southerly along the said Eastern boundary to the Northern boundary of Fern Road; thence in a generally Westerly direction along the said Northern boundary, to the Western boundary of lot 31, Chapman Road; thence North-Westerly to and along the Western boundaries of lots 14 and 10, Riverton Street, and lots 15 and 16, Manning Road, and their prolongation to the Northern boundary of Manning Road; thence Easterly along the said Northern boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 45, Manning Road; thence Easterly along the Northern boundaries of the said lot 45 and part lot 19, Manning Road, and lot 49, unnamed street, situated between Chapman and Manning Roads, and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of the unnamed street; thence South-Easterly along the said Eastern boundary to the Southern boundary of Mitchell Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Southern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 49, Mitchell Street; thence South-Easterly along the said Western boundary to the Southern boundary of the said lot 49; thence North-Easterly along the said Southern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of the right of way at the rear of the lots fronting Second Avenue; thence South-Easterly along the Eastern boundary of the said right of way to the Northern boundary of lot 44, Second Avenue; thence North-Easterly along the said boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of Second Avenue; thence South-Easterly along the said Eastern boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 2, Second Avenue; thence North-Easterly along the Northern boundary of the said lot 2 and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of the right of way between Second and First Avenues; thence North-Westerly along the Eastern boundary of the said right of way to the Northern boundary of lot 27, First Avenue; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of First Avenue; thence South-Easterly along the said Eastern boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 12, First Avenue; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of the right of way between First Avenue and Albany Highway; thence South-Easterly along the Eastern boundary of the said right of way to the Northern boundary of lot 10, Albany Highway; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of Albany Highway; thence North-Westerly along the said Eastern boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 63, Albany Highway; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 61, Radium Street; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary, to and across Radium Street, to its Northern boundary; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 16, Radium Street; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary to the Western corner of the said lot 16; thence North-Easterly along the Northern boundaries of lots 16 and 17, Radium Street, to the Western boundary of lot 37, Alexandra Avenue; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary, to and across Alexandra Avenue, to its Northern boundary; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of

lot 48, Alexandra Avenue; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary to the Southern corner of lot 53, Acton Avenue; thence South-Westerly to and along the Southern boundaries of lots 54 to 59, inclusive, Acton Avenue, to the Western boundary of the said lot 59; thence North-Westerly along the Western boundary of the said lot 59, to and across Acton Avenue, to and along the Western boundaries of lot 63, Acton Avenue and lot 80, Ewing Street, and their prolongation to the Northern boundary of Ewing Street; thence South-Westerly along the said Northern boundary to the Eastern boundary of Albany Highway; thence North-Westerly along the said Northern boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 185, Albany Highway; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of the right of way at the rear of the lots fronting Albany Highway; thence North-Westerly along the Eastern boundary of the said right of way to the Southern boundary of John Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Southern boundary to the Western boundary of Catherine Street; thence North-Westerly across John Street, to and along the Western boundary of Catherine Street, to the Northern boundary of Isobel Street; thence South-Westerly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 24, Isobel Street; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary to the Eastern corner of lot 12, Tate Street; thence South-Westerly along the Southern boundaries of lots 12 and 11, Tate Street, to the Western boundary of the said lot 11; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary and its prolongation to the Northern boundary of Tate Street; thence South-Westerly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 640, Tate Street; thence Northerly along the said Western boundary to the Southern boundary of lot 45, Ellam Street; thence Westerly along the said Southern boundary to the Western boundary of the said lot 45; thence Northerly along the said boundary to the East corner of lot 16, Norman Street; thence Westerly along the Southern boundary of the said lot 16 and its prolongation to the Western boundary of Norman Street; thence Northerly along the said Western boundary to the Southern boundary of lot 8, Norman Street; thence Westerly along the said Southern boundary to, and along, the Southern boundary of lot 5, Albany Highway and its prolongation to the Western boundary of Albany Highway; thence Northerly along the said Western boundary to the Southern boundary of lot 264, Albany Highway; thence South-Westerly along the said Southern boundary to the Western boundary of the said lot 264; thence Northerly along the Southern boundaries of the said lot 264 and lot 263, Albany Highway, and their prolongation to the Northern boundary of Victoria Street; thence South-Westerly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 9, Victoria Street; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary to the Eastern corner of lot 11, Salisbury Street; thence South-Westerly along the Southern boundaries of lot 11 and 14, Salisbury Street, to the Western boundary of the said lot 14; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary and its prolongation to the Northern boundary of Salisbury Street; thence South-Westerly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 17, Salisbury Street; thence North-Westerly along the Western boundary of the said lot 17 to the East corner of lot 19, Boundary Road; thence South-Westerly along the Southern boundary of the said lot 19 to its Western boundary; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary and its prolongation to the Northern boundary of Boundary Road; thence South-Westerly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 191, Boundary Road; thence North-Westerly along the Western boundaries of the said lot 191 and lot 113, Wyndham Street, to and across Wyndham Street, to and along the Western boundary of lot 72, Wyndham Street, to the Northern boundary of the said lot 72; thence North-Easterly along the Northern boundaries of lots 72, 71 and 70, Wyndham Street, to the Southern corner of lot 55, Leichardt Street; thence North-Westerly along the Western boundary of the said lot 55, to and across Leichardt Street,

to and along the Western boundary of lot 8, Leichardt Street, to the Northern boundary of the said lot 8; thence North-Easterly along the Northern boundaries of lots 8 to 3, inclusive, Leichardt Street, and lot 1, Albany Highway, and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of Albany Highway; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 475, Albany Highway; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary, to and across the right of way, between Albany Highway and Hay Street, to the Western boundary of lot 485, Hay Street; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary to the Northern boundary of the said lot 485; thence North-Westerly along the said Northern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of Hay Street; thence North-Westerly along the said Eastern boundary to the Southern boundary of Oats Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Southern boundary to the Eastern boundary of the right of way between Shepperton Road and Swansea Street; thence South-Easterly along the said Eastern boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 504, Swansea Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of Swansea Street; thence South-Easterly along the said Eastern boundary to the Northern boundary of lot 2, Swansea Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 201, Oats Street; thence North-Westerly along the said Western boundary to the Southern boundary of Oats Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Southern boundary to the Eastern boundary of lot 10, Oats Street; thence in a generally South-Westerly direction along the said Eastern boundary to the Northern boundary of part lot 209, Bank Street; thence Easterly along the said Northern boundary to the Western boundary of lot 6, Bank Street; thence North-Westerly along the Western boundaries of the said lot 6 and lot 5, Bank Street, to the Northern boundary of the said lot 5; thence Easterly along the said Northern boundary to and across Bank Street, to and across the Great Southern Railway Reserve to the centre of the said Railway Reserve; thence Southerly along the said Railway Reserve, to a point opposite the Southern boundary of John Street; thence South-Westerly across the Railway Reserve, to and across Railway Promenade, to and along the said Southern boundary across Charles Street, to its Western boundary; thence South-Easterly along the said Western boundary to the Southern boundary of lot 172, John Street; thence South-Westerly along the Southern boundaries of lots 172 and 173, John Street, to the Eastern boundary of lot 206, Catherine Street; thence South-Easterly along the Eastern boundaries of lots 206 and 205, Catherine Street, to the Northern boundary of lot 209, Charles Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary and its prolongation to the Eastern boundary of Charles Street; thence South-Easterly along the said Western boundary to the Northern boundary of Ewing Street; thence North-Easterly along the said Northern boundary to and across Railway Promenade, to and across the Great Southern Railway Reserve, to the centre of the said Railway Reserve; thence South-Easterly along the centre of the said Railway Reserve, to the point of commencement, as shown in orange on Plan M.W.S.S & D.D., W.A., No. 7087.

Re-Description of District Boundaries.

1919-1956, doth hereby re-describe the district boundaries of the Mundaring Road District as described in the Schedule hereto.

Re-description of District Boundaries.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting at the South-Western corner of lot 129 of Swan Location 16 (L.T.O. Diagram 266) and extending Easterly along its Southern boundary; thence generally North-Easterly along the South-Eastern boundaries of lots 129 and 83 (L.T.O. Plan 2457) and onwards along the South-Eastern side of a right-of-way to the South-Western side of Bulbey Street and again onwards to and along the South-Eastern side of Irwin Street to the South-Western side of Wilkins Street; thence South-Easterly along that side to the North-Western corner of lot 239 (L.T.O. Diagram 2029); thence South-Westerly, Easterly and North-Easterly along boundaries of that lot; thence generally South-Easterly along the Southern sides of Wilkins Street aforesaid and onwards to the Western boundary of location 5577; thence Southerly and Easterly along boundaries of that location and onwards to the Eastern side of Scott Street (road No. 6466); thence generally Northerly along that side to the South-Western side of the Greenmount-Midland Junction Railway Reserve; thence generally North-Westerly along that side to the Northern corner of location 5577 aforesaid; thence Northerly to and along the Eastern side of Ruby Street; thence generally North-Westerly along the South-Western sides of Great Eastern Highway to a point situate in prolongation Southerly of the Eastern side of Bushby Street; thence Northerly to and along that side to the Southern side of Morrison Road (road No. 1985); thence Easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation Southerly of the Western boundary of location 1450; thence Northerly along that prolongation to the Northern side of Morrison Road aforesaid; thence Easterly along that side to the Eastern side of Myles Road (road No. 5783); thence Northerly along that side to the North-Western corner of location 1775; thence Easterly along the Northern boundary of that location; thence Northerly along the Western side of Talbot Road to the Northern alignment of O'Connor Road; thence Easterly to and along the Northern side of that road and onwards to the Western boundary of location 1114; thence Northerly, Easterly and again Northerly along boundaries of that location; thence Easterly along the Southern boundary of location 12 to a point situate in prolongation Southerly of the Eastern boundary of location 1253; thence Northerly to and along that boundary; thence Easterly along the Southernmost boundary of location 1317 and the Southern side of Cameron Road (road No. 10668) and onwards to the South-Western corner of lot 155 of location 1317 (L.T.O. Diagram 12424); thence Northerly, Easterly and Southerly along boundaries of lots 155, 91, 92 and 51 (L.T.O.
