Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 45 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1954, that after the requirements of the section have been complied with, the Governor may forthwith make an Order empowering a water board to undertake the construction of the waterworks within a water area; and whereas by Order in Council made on the 1st February, 1957, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 15th February, 1957, the Governor empowered the Minister to undertake the construction of waterworks within the Williams Water Area, and such construction was duly commenced; and whereas under the provisions of section 8 of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1954, the area comprised within the Williams Water Area has been constituted a country water area named the Williams Country Water Area: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, having approved under the provisions of section 45 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1954, of the plans, sections, specifications and estimates for the construction of waterworks within the Williams Water Area, hereby empowers the Minister under the provisions of section 18 of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1954, to complete the construction of the said waterworks within the Williams Country Water Area.
