WHEREAS by Clause 14 of the Letters Patent under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom constituting the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies, bearing date the 29th October, 1900, it is provided that in the event of the Governor having occasion to be temporarily absent from the seat of Government or from the State, he may in every such case, by an instrument under the Public Seal of the State, constitute and appoint the Lieutenant-Governor to be his Deputy during such absence, and in that capacity to exercise, perform and execute, for and on behalf of the Governor, during such absence but no longer, all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor by such Letters Patent as shall in and by such instrument be specified.

And whereas I, the said Governor, propose to absent myself temporarily from the seat of Government: Now therefore I, the said Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, do by this instrument under the Public Seal of the State constitute and appoint you the said Sir John Patrick Dwyer as from the date of my departure upon the said absence, to be

my Deputy and in that capacity to exercise, perform and execute, for and on my behalf, as such Governor, all the powers and authorities vested in me by the said Letters Patent.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, on the 10th day of July, 1957, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Forests Act, 1918-1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 266/55.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation.
- (b) After such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council, revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the 10th day of November, 1955, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown Lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest No. 51 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto.

F.D. 896/52.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation.
- (b) After such proposal has been laid before Parliament, the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council, revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency, the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposals dated the 13th day of August, 1952, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposals had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposals should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown Lands as State Forest No. 4 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto.
