WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 15 of the Wheat Products (Prices Fixation) Act, 1938-1939, that the Governor may from time to time, on the recommendation of the Wheat Products Prices Committee constituted pursuant to the Act, by Proclamation fix the minimum and the maximum price at which substances included in the definition of wheat products may be sold in the State, or in any specified part of the State, by the manufacturer thereof or by any person, and that the Governor may from time to time revoke or vary any Proclamation under the section by a subsequent Proclamation; and whereas the Governor by Proclamation dated the 8th day of August, 1956, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 10th day of August, 1956, fixed the prices at which bread, being a wheat product within the meaning of the Act, may be sold by any person in the various parts of the State specified in that Proclamation; and whereas that Proclamation was varied by Proclamations dated the 5th day of September, 1956, and the 3rd day of April, 1957, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 7th day of September, 1956, and the 5th day of April, 1957, respectively; and whereas it is now considered necessary and expedient to vary the Proclamation dated the 8th day of August, 1956, as varied by Proclamations dated the 5th day of September, 1956,

and the 3rd day of April, 1957, so far as it applies to the townsite of Broome: Now therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Wheat Products Prices Committee and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon me by the Act do hereby further vary the Proclamation dated the 8th day of August, 1956, as so varied, by deleting the maximum prices in respect of sales of bread within the boundaries of the townsite of Broome, as specified in the table contained in paragraph (a) of the Fourth Schedule and substituting in lieu thereof the following maximum prices:—

#### Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders Act, 1921-1936.

##### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by subsection (3) of section 14 of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders Act, 1921, as amended by Acts No. 29 of 1923 and No. 7 of 1936, the Governor may, upon being satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made or are about to be made by the legislation of any part of the Queen's Dominions or other competent authority, for the enforcement within that part of maintenance orders made by courts within this State by Order in Council extend the provisions of the said Act to that part of the Queen's Dominions; and whereas the Governor is satisfied that such reciprocal provisions have been made by the Bailiwick of Guernsey: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby extend the provisions of the said Act to the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

#### Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956.

##### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 8774/57.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor-in-Council: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

#### Metropolitan Water Reticulation.

Swan Road District and Darling Range Road District.

Proposed Feeder Main in Vale Road and Kalamunda Road.

The construction of a 10-inch diameter water main (length about 10,380 feet).

The above main to be complete with valves, fittings and all necessary apparatus.

The above works are shown in red on Plan M.W.S. 8135.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 9th day of August, 1957.
