Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954. Reserve for Natives.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency The Honourable Sir John TO WIT, JOHN PATRICK DWYER, Lieutenant-Governor. IL.S.J By His Excellency The Honourable Sir John Patrick Dwyer, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Do-pendencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by section 11 of the Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954, it is provided that the Governor is empowered by Proclamation to declare Crown lands to be reserves for natives; or alter the boundaries of

a reserve; or abolish a reserve; and whereas it is deemed desirable to alter the boundaries of native reserve No. 23232 situated at Meekatharra as described by Proclamation published in the Govern-ment Gazette on the 19th October, 1951: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Native Welfare Act, 1905-1954, do hereby amend reserve No. 23232 as described in the Schedule hereto.

Of reserve No. 23232 (Kyarra Location 40— Natives) being amended to include that area now designated as Kyarra Location 44 and of its area being increased to about 17 acres accordingly.

4. This Order in Council shall take effect on the 1st day of October, 1957.

4. This Order in Council shall take effect on the first day of November, 1957.

- (2) for operating theatre fees, such amount as would normally be payable to the hospital concerned in cases other than workers' compensation cases, or in a public hospital the sum of £3 3s.
