Forests Act, 1918-1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 1059/56.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

(a) the Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation;

(b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council, revoke such dedication,

And whereas His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the 1st day of November, 1956, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown land as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest No. 28 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto.
