HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to approve of the by-laws made by the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage under and for the purposes of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1954, as set out in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

By-laws.

1. In these by-laws the by-laws made by the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage under and for the purposes of the Country Areas Water Supply Act, 1947-1954, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 20th June, 1957, are referred to as the principal by-laws.
2. Paragraph (e) of by-law 89 of the principal by-laws is amended—
 - (a) by deleting the word "and" in line four of subparagraph (i);
 - (b) by adding subparagraphs as follows:—
 - (iii) for the year ending on the 30th day of September in respect of the following rating zone—Manjimup;
 - (iv) for the year ending on the 31st day of October in respect of the following rating zones:—Albany, Boddington, Dalwallinu, Kojonup, Mingenew, Morawa, Moora, Wongan Hills.
3. The principal by-laws are amended by adding after by-law 95 a by-law as follows:—

95A. Where rates of prices or charges are prescribed in the Schedule to these by-laws, for water supplied to ships from any rating zone, the prices or charges shall be paid by the masters or agents of the ships to which water is so supplied at the rates so prescribed.

4. The Schedule to the principal by-laws is amended by adding after the table "(41) Waroona Rating Zone" the following tables:—

Schedule.

Regulations.

1. In these regulations the Mines Regulation Act Regulations made under the Mines Regulation Act, 1946, reprinted pursuant to the reprinting of Regulations Act, 1954, in the *Government Gazette*, on the 25th July, 1956, with all amendments up to and including the 29th June, 1955, and further amended by notices published in the *Government Gazette* on the 8th June, 1956; the 29th June, 1956; the 22nd February, 1957 and the 1st May, 1957, are referred to as the principal regulations.

2. Subregulation (1) of regulation 14 of the principal regulations is amended—

- (a) by substituting for the expression "£23 2s. 4d." in line three the expression "£26 19s. 7d.";
- (b) by substituting for the expression "13th April, 1955" in line five the expression "1st May, 1957";
- (c) by substituting for the passage "the coming into operation of this regulation" in lines one and two of the proviso the passage "that date."
