AT a meeting of the Executive Council, held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, on the 31st day of October, 1957, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956.

Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1,
Victoria Park Extension.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 275/57.

WHEREAS by section 7 (a) of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that the Governor may, by Order in Council, alter or extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Area, or of any district, or Metropolitan Main Drainage District; and whereas it is desirable that the boundaries of Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 as at present defined should be altered: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby extend the boundaries of Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 and declare that the said boundaries, as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 7087, and as described in Order in Council of 19th June, 1957, shall be extended in the following manner by adding the area described in the Schedule hereunder and including it in Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1.

Schedule.

All that portion of land, bounded by lines commencing at the south-western boundary of Gallipoli Street and the centre of the South-Western Railway Reserve adjacent to Victoria Park Station, and proceeding in a north-easterly direction along the eastern side of Gallipoli Street to the northern boundary of lot 401, Staines Street; thence in an easterly direction along the southern side of Staines Street to the eastern side of Goddard Street; thence southerly along Goddard Street to the northern boundary of lot 6, Bishopsgate Street; thence easterly along the said boundary; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of lot 6 to its south-

ern boundary; thence in a south-easterly direction along the south-western boundaries of lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, Bishopsgate Street; thence continuing in a south-westerly direction along the western boundaries of lots 12, 13, 14, Forster Avenue, to the north-eastern boundary of lot 15, Forster Avenue; thence in a south-easterly direction along the south-western boundary of the said lot 15 to the eastern side of Forster Avenue; thence proceeding in a southerly direction along the eastern side of Forster Avenue, to and across Rutland Avenue to the centre of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence south-easterly along the centre of the said Southern Railway Reserve to Archer Street; thence proceeding in a north-easterly direction along the north side of Archer Street to the south-western boundary of lot 4, Archer Street; thence north-westerly and north-easterly along the boundaries of the said lot 4 and continuing in a north-easterly direction along the north-western boundaries of lots 3, 2 and 1, Archer Street, to the south-western boundary of lot 479, Raleigh Street; thence north-westerly and north-easterly along the boundaries of the said lot, to and across Raleigh Street and continuing in a north-easterly direction along the north-western boundaries of lot 484, Raleigh Street, and lot 525, Bishopsgate Street, to and across Bishopsgate Street; thence in a north-westerly direction along the south-western and north-western boundaries of lot 531, Bishopsgate Street, to a right-of-way; thence north-westerly along the said right-of-way to the north-western boundary of lot 564; thence north-easterly along the boundary of the said lot, to and across Planet Street to the south-western boundary of lot 584, Planet Street; thence in a north-westerly and north-easterly direction along the boundaries of the said lot to a right-of-way; thence north-westerly along the said right-of-way to the north-western boundary of lot 603, Mars Street; thence north-easterly along the said boundary to Mars Street; thence proceeding in a north-westerly direction along the western side of Mars Street, to and across Roberts Road, and continuing along the west side of McCartney Crescent to a point opposite the prolongation of the north-western boundary of lot 45, McCartney Crescent; thence proceeding in a north-easterly direction along the north-western boundary of lot 45 to the south-western boundary of lot 58, Howick Street; thence in a north-westerly

and northerly direction along the boundaries of the said lot to the west side of Howick Street; thence proceeding in a north-westerly direction along Howick Street to the north side of Rayment Street; thence proceeding in a north-easterly direction along Rayment Street, to and along the western side of Petherbridge Street to a point opposite the prolongation of the north-eastern boundary of lot 339, Petherbridge Street; thence in a north-easterly and south-easterly direction along the boundaries of the said lot, and along the eastern boundary of lot 243, Enfield Street, to Enfield Street; thence proceeding in an easterly direction along the south side of Enfield Street to the eastern boundary of lot 333, Getting Street; thence in a south-westerly direction along the said lot to its southern boundary; thence south-easterly across Getting Street and along the eastern boundary of lot 338, Getting Street; thence in a south-westerly direction along the south-eastern boundary of the said lot and continuing along the south-eastern boundaries of lots 343, 346, Getting Street; thence south-easterly and south-westerly along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundary of lot 352, Roberts Road, and continuing along the south-eastern boundary of lot 353; thence proceeding in a south-easterly direction across Roberts Road and along the south-western boundaries of lots 817 to 831, inclusive, Star Street; thence in a north-easterly direction along the south-eastern boundary of lot 1, Weston Street; thence proceeding in a south-easterly direction along the north-eastern boundaries of lots 901 and 900, Weston Street; thence north-easterly across Weston Street and south-easterly along the northern side of Weston Street to Lion Street; thence proceeding in a north-easterly direction along the north side of Lion Street to a point opposite the prolongation of the north boundary of lot 956, Lion Street; thence in a south-easterly direction across Lion Street and along the northern boundaries of lots 956, 957, 958, 959; thence along the south-eastern boundary of lot 959 to Weston Street; thence proceeding in a south-easterly direction along the northern side of Weston Street to the southern boundary of lot 963, Weston Street; thence south-westerly across Weston Street and along the southern boundaries of lots 875, Weston Street, and 858, Star Street, to the south-eastern boundary of lot 219, Star Street; thence south-easterly along the western side of Star Street, to and along the southern boundary of lot 215; thence south-easterly along a right-of-way, to and along the southern boundary of lot 205, Mars Street; thence proceeding in a south-easterly direction along the eastern side of Mars Street to Oats Street, and continuing to the south-eastern boundary of lot 692, Mars Street; thence south-westerly across Mars Street and along the south-eastern boundary of lot 661, Mars Street, to a right-of-way; thence in a south-easterly direction along the said right-of-way to the southern boundary of lot 558, Planet Street; thence south-westerly along the said lot 558 to Planet Street; thence south-easterly along the eastern side of Planet Street to Briggs Street; thence in a south-westerly direction along the western side of Briggs Street to Tuckett Street; thence northerly along the east side of Tuckett Street to a point opposite the prolongation of the north-eastern boundary of lot 828, Tuckett Street; thence south-westerly along the boundary of lot 828, to the centre of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence proceeding northerly along the said Railway Reserve to a point opposite the prolongation of the southern boundary of lot 4, Bank Street; thence westerly along the boundary of lot 4 to the eastern boundary of lot 9, Oats Street; thence southerly, westerly and north-westerly along the boundaries of the said lot 9 to Oats Street; thence south-westerly along the south side of Oats Street to the west boundary of lot 201, Oats Street; thence south-easterly along the west boundary of the said lot 201 to the north boundary of lot 2, Swansea Street; thence south-westerly and north-westerly along the boundaries of the said lot 2; thence south-westerly across Swansea Street and along the southern and north-western boundaries of lot 503 to the north-west boundary of lot 502, Swan Street; thence south-westerly along the south side of Oats Street to the west side of Shepperton Road; thence northerly along Shepperton Road to the northern boundary of lot 23, Shepperton Road; thence south-westerly along the north boundary of

the said lot 23 to the west side of Hay Street; thence north-westerly along Hay Street to the north side of Somerset Street; thence westerly along Somerset Street to the south-west corner of lot 1, Hubert Street; thence north-westerly along a right-of-way to the northern boundary of lot 586, Hubert Street; thence north-easterly along the north boundary of the said lot 586 to the east side of Hubert Street; thence north-westerly along the east side of Hubert Street to the northern boundary of lot 344, Hubert Street; thence easterly along the north boundary of the said lot 344 to a right-of-way; thence northerly along the said right-of-way to the northern boundary of lot 299, Swansea Street; thence easterly along the north boundary of the said lot 299 to the east side of Swansea Street; thence north-westerly along Swansea Street to the northern boundary of lot 162; thence easterly along the said lot boundary to a right-of-way; thence north-westerly along the said right-of-way to the north boundary of lot 203, Shepperton Road; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said lot to the east side of Shepperton Road; thence north-westerly along the east side of Shepperton Road to the northern boundary of lot 132; thence easterly along the north boundary of the said lot 132 and north-westerly along the western boundaries of lots 131, 130, Shepperton Road, to the north side of Miller Street and the west boundary of lot 409, Miller Street; thence easterly along the north side of Miller Street to the western boundary of lot 406, Miller Street; thence northerly and westerly along the boundary of the said lot 406 to the western boundary of lot 3, Teague Street; thence north-westerly, along the western boundaries of lots 3, 2, 1, 4, 3, 2, 1, 400, to the northern boundary of lot 399, Teague Street; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said lot 399, to and along the western and northern boundaries of lot 398, Teague Street, to the south side of Gresham Street; thence north-easterly along the south side of Gresham Street; thence north-westerly and easterly along the boundaries of lot 240, Gresham Street; thence north-westerly and north-easterly along the boundaries of lot 236, Sunbury Street, to the east side of Sunbury Street; thence north-westerly along Sunbury Street to the north boundary of lot 284, Sunbury Street; thence north-easterly along the said north boundary of lot 284 to the western boundary of lot 2, Kitchener Avenue; thence north-westerly along the western boundaries of lot 1, 272, Kitchener Avenue; thence north-easterly along the northern boundary of the said lot 272 and continuing across Kitchener Avenue to the centre of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence north-westerly along the said South-Western Railway Reserve to the point of commencement, as shown in green on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A., No. 7087.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 15th day of November, 1957.

Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1956.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1956, that it shall be obligatory for every employer to obtain from an incorporated insurance office approved by the Minister, a policy of insurance for the full amount of the liability to pay compensation under the Act to all workers employed by him, but that if an employer proves to the satisfaction of the Minister that such employer has established a fund for insurance against such liability and has deposited at the Treasury securities charged with all payments to become due under such liability the Governor may, by Order in Council, exempt such employer from the operation of the said section; and whereas Midland Railway Company of Western Australia Limited, of Midland Junction, Western Australia, being an employer within the meaning of the Act and having made application in accordance with the Act and the regulations made thereunder for exemption from the operation of section 13, has satisfied the Minister that it has

established a fund for insurance against its liability to pay compensation under the Act to all workers employed by it, and has deposited at the Treasury a security, to wit, a bond for ten thousand pounds charged with all payments to become due under the liability: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the

powers conferred by the Act, doth hereby exempt Midland Railway Company of Western Australia Limited from the operation of section 13 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1956, until and including the 7th day of August, 1959.
