WHEREAS by paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 94A of Part VIA of the Police Act, 1892-1956, it is provided that if it appears to the Governor that any new derivative of morphine or cocaine nor that any new derivative of morphine or cocaine or of any salts of morphine or cocaine or any other alkaloid of opium or any other drug of whatever kind is or is likely to be productive, if improperly used, of ill effects substantially of the same character or nature as or analogous to those produced by morphine or cocaine, the Governor may by Proclamation published in the Gazette, declare that Part VIA of that Act shall apply to that new derivative or alkaloid or other drug in the same manner as it applies to the drugs mentioned in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 94A of that Act; and whereas it appears to the Governor that the drugs mentioned in the Schedule hereunder are likely to be productive, if improperly used, of ill-effects substantially of the same character or nature as or analogous to those produced by morphine or cocaine: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 94A of Part VIA of the Police Act, 1892-1956, hereby declare that Part VIA of that Act shall apply to the drugs mentioned in the Schedule hereunder in the same manner as it applies to the drugs mentioned in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of or of any salts of morphine or cocaine or any other under in the same manner as it applies to the drugs mentioned in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of that section of the Act.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 28 of the Companies Act, 1943-1954, that no company shall be registered by a name which, *inter alia*, in the opinion of the Registrar of Companies, so nearly resembles the name by which a company in existence is already registered under the law relating to companies as to be calculated to deceive;

and whereas it is provided, inter alia, in proviso (a) to subsection (7) of that section that where in the opinion of the Governor, (on being satisfied that it would be inequitable or unreasonable to require a company incorporated outside Western Australia to which Part XI of that Act applies to change its name before complying with the requirements of that Part) it is in the circumstances of the particular case expedient, the Governor may authorise the Registrar to accept for filing the documents and particulars specified in paragraphs (a) to (f) inclusive of subsection (1) of section 329 of that Act; and whereas registration under Part XI of the Act of a company incorporated in the State of New South Wales by the name of Emmco Sales Pty. Limited was refused by the Registrar on the ground that in his opinion that name so nearly resembles the name by which a company in existence (namely, Emco Investments Pty. Ltd.) is already registered under the law relating to companies, as to be calculated to deceive; and whereas His Excellency the Governor is satisfied that it would be inequitable or unreasonable to require Emmco Sales Pty. Limited to change its name before complying with the requirements of Part XI of the said Companies Act and is of the opinion that the circumstances of the case render it expedient: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by proviso (a) to subsection (7) of section 28 of the Companies Act, 1943-1954, doth hereby authorise the Registrar of Companies to accept for filing from Emmco Sales Pty. Limited the documents and particulars specified in paragraphs (a) to (f) inclusive of subsection (1) of section 329 of that Act.
