TRAFFIC ACT, 1919-1957.

Notice.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subparagraph (1) of paragraph 15 under the heading "License Fees for Motor Vehicles" in Part 1 of the Third Schedule to the Traffic Act, 1919-1957, that where the fuel used for propelling a motor vehicle is not motor spirit as defined in paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section eleven of that Act, the license fee for that vehicle shall, subject to the provisions of subparagraph (2) of the said paragraph 15, be double the rate prescribed for that vehicle in Part 1 of the Third Schedule; and whereas it is further enacted by subparagraph (2) of the said paragraph 15 that the Minister may, in such cases as he thinks proper, by notice published in the *Gazette*, reduce any fee referred to in subparagraph (1) of that paragraph and that the fee as so reduced shall be payable in accordance with that notice; and whereas I, Herbert Ernst Graham, Minister for Traffic, being the Minister referred to in that paragraph, think it

proper that the license fee for every motor vehicle which comes within the meaning of the expression "road vehicle" as defined hereunder and for propelling which automotive diesel fuel is used, should be reduced: Now, therefore I, the said Minister for Traffic, do hereby, with effect from the 1st January, 1958, reduce the license fee for every motor vehicle, which comes within the meaning of the expression "road vehicle" as so defined and for propelling which automotive diesel fuel is used, to an amount which is equivalent to the license fee which would be payable in respect of that vehicle if motor spirit were used for propelling it.

In this notice the expression—

"road vehicle" means a motor vehicle designed solely or principally for the transporting by road of persons, goods, or animals, but does not include a motor vehicle used as an excavator, road grader, bulldozer, road roller, power shovel, earth mover, agricultural tractor or fork lift truck.
