WHEREAS by the Transfer of Land Act, 1893-1950, the Governor is empowered, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, to revest in Her Majesty as of her former estate all or any lands, whereof Her Majesty may become the registered proprietor; and whereas Her Majesty is now the registered proprietor of the lands described in the schedule hereto: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this Proclamation revest in Her Majesty, her heirs and successors the lands described in the schedule hereto as of her former estate.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1956, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or per-

sons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order, and with power of sub-leasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient that reserve 24748 (Canning Location 1363) should vest in and be held by the Kelmscott Road Board in trust for Public Utility: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Kelmscott Road Board in trust for Public Utility with power to the said Kelmscott Road Board to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserve for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease.

City of Perth and Belmont Park Road Board District.

Proposed Victoria Park-Mount Yokine 42-Inch Trunk Main.

First Section Victoria Park to Belmont.

(a) The laying of a 42-inch nominal diameter steel water main (length approximately four miles) together with the installation of valves, and all other necessary apparatus connected therewith.

(b) The laying of approximately 500 feet of 24-inch nominal diameter steel water main.

The above works are shown in red on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D. W.A., No. 8156.

Bunbury Water Board—Proposed Loan of £10,000.
