WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Courts of Session Act, 1921, the Governor by Proclamation dated the 7th day of November, 1940, published in the Government Gazette, dated the 8th day of November, 1940, did, inter alia, establish for each Session Division constituted under that Act a Court of Session and appoint places at which sittings of those Courts of Session for those Session Divisions shall respectively be held; and whereas by section 17 of the Act it is provided, inter alia, that the Governor may by proclamation allow a Court of Session of a Division to sit temporarily at any place within the Division other than the place appointed in accordance with that section; and whereas by the said Proclamation dated the 7th day of November, 1940, the Courthouse, Cue, was duly appointed as the place within the Murchison Division where the sittings of the Court of that Division shall be held: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby allow the Court of Session for the Murchison Division to sit temporarily at the Court House, Mount Magnet, within that Division, in lieu of the Courthouse, Cue, during the special sitting of the Court directed pursuant to section 18 of that Act, to be held commencing on the 12th day of February, 1958.
