ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section 7 (a) of the Metropolitan Water Supply, Severage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that the Governor may, by Order in Council, alter or extend the boundaries of the Metropolitan Water, Severage and Drainage Area, or of any district, or Metropolitan Main Drainage District; and whereas it is desirable that the boundaries of Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 as at present defined should be altered: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby extend the boundaries of Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1 and declare that the said boundaries, as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D. W.A. No. 7087, and as described in Order in Council of 19th June, 1957, shall be extended in the following manner by adding the area described in Metropolitan Main Drainage District No. 1.
