WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Lieutenant-General Sir Charles
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F.D. 219/53, Ex. Co. No. 457.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 9 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1956, I, the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever by means of fishing nets in all those portions of Western Australian waters specified in the Schedule hereto from 1st January to 30th April and from 1st November to 31st December, all days inclusive, in every year.

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1956, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or persons to be named in the order in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order: And whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corr. No. 1286/56.—That reserve No. 24518 should vest in and be held by the Halls Creek Road Board in trust for Road Board Purposes.

Corr. No. 4839/48.—That reserve No. 24945 should vest in and be held by the Katanning Road Board in trust for the purpose of Children's Play Ground.

board to make, repeal, and alter by-laws for the control and management of such reserves, and prescribe fees for depasturing thereon or other use thereof, and for other purposes, such by-laws to be approved by the Governor and published in the *Government Gazette*; and whereas it is deemed expedient that reserve No. 17841 for the purpose of Water should be placed under the control of Messrs. 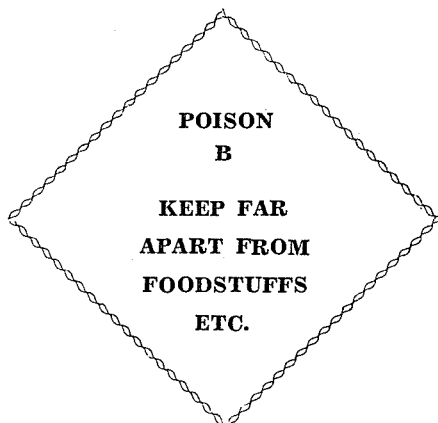
(ii) Baits, Dingo (Strychnine)—See packing clause B vi. Copper Sulphate 100%—See packing clause B v.

(b) Packing Requirements.—Class B poisons shall be packed as follows when accepted on normal receiving days:—

- (i) 44 gallon drums. Only new steel drums of not less than 18 gauge shall be used. Drums with severe dents due to rough handling shall be rejected.
- (ii) 4 gallon drums. Only new drums, lined where necessary shall be used. Drums with severe dents due to rough handling shall be rejected.
- (iii) 1 gallon tins shall be packed in wooden boxes or new corrugated cardboard or fibreboard cartons of sufficient strength to give adequate protection. Wood shavings or sawdust may be used and the tins shall be tightly packed so that they cannot move in the cases. Not more than six tins shall be packed in one outer container.
- (iv) Small packages in tins, bottles or cartons shall be packed in wooden boxes or new fibreboard or corrugated cardboard cartons of adequate strength to protect the contents from crushing or breakage. The individual containers shall be separated by wooden, corrugated cardboard or fibreboard partitions and sawdust or other packing material may be used. The contents of the case shall be tightly packed so that no movement is possible inside the package. Not more than two gallons in bottles or six gallons in tins shall be packed in any one outer container.
- (v) Powders must be packed in strong jute or hessian sacks, lined with waterproof paper to render them siftproof.

(vi) Strychnine dingo baits, consisting of a pellet of strychnine in a piece of fat, each bait individually wrapped in grease proof paper, will be accepted in the original unbroken wooden boxes. If the quantity is less than a case lot, the baits shall be repacked in sealed metal containers.
