IN pursuance of the provisions of section 9 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1956, I, the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby, in exercise of the powers aforesaid and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, prohibit the taking of any fish whatsoever by any means of capture whatsoever, in the whole of the Western Australian waters specified in the Schedule hereto for a period of three months from 1st April, 1958, until 30th June, 1958.

Schedule.

All that portion of the Indian Ocean, bounded on the east by the high water mark; on the south by an east-west line situate one mile south of the Sewerage Treatment Works Outfall Sewer adjacent to Swanbourne Rifle Range; on the west by a line parallel to and one and a half miles from the high water mark aforesaid; and on the north by an east-west line situate one and a half miles north of the Outfall Sewer aforesaid.
