PERTH:

WHEREAS subsection (2) of section 121 of the Licensing Act, 1911-1956, is as follows:—

- (2) No licensee shall in the Goldfields district-
 - (a) have or keep his licensed premises open for the sale of liquor; or
 - (b) sell any liquor or permit or suffer any liquor to be drunk or consumed in or upon his licensed premises,

at any time before nine o'clock in the morning or after eleven o'clock at night upon any day in the week, except under the authority of an occasional license.

Penalty: For a first offence, fifty pounds; for any subsequent offence, one hundred pounds:

Provided that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Licensing Court, by Proclamation, extend or reduce the hours in any licensing district or part of a district within the Goldfields district, and this subsection shall have effect as so modified, but any such Proclamation may, on the recommendation of the Licensing Court, be varied or revoked by a subsequent Proclamation.

And whereas by a Proclamation dated the 7th May, 1952, the hours were extended in respect of publicans' general licenses, hotel licenses and wayside-house licenses in specified districts within the Goldfields district and by Proclamation dated the 20th February, 1953, were extended in respect of those publicans' general licenses within the Kalgoorlie Licensing District specified therein and

by a Proclamation dated the 31st August, 1955, were further extended in respect of publicans' genwere further extended in respect of publicans general licenses, hotel licenses and wayside-house licenses within the Kalgoorlie Licensing District; and whereas the Licensing Court on the 15th January, 1958, made a recommendation to the Governor in respect of those hours: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Licensing Court, do hereby proclaim as follows: as follows:-

- (1) The Second Schedule of the Proclamation dated the 7th May, 1952, is hereby varied by deleting the words, "Coolgardie" and "Kanowna" therefrom.
- (2) Subparagraph (b) of paragraph (1) of the Proclamation dated the 20th February, 1953, is hereby varied by substituting for the passage, "10.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m." the passage, "11 a.m. and 1 p.m."
- (3) Subparagraph (b) of paragraph (3) of the Proclamation dated the 31st August, 1955, is hereby varied by substituting for the passage, "10.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m." the passage, "11 a.m. and 1 p.m."
- (4) The holder of a publican's general license, hotel license or wayside-house license in respect of premises in the Coolgardie Licensing District and the Kanowna Licensing District, being districts within the Goldfields District, shall not, at any time-

have or keep the licensed premises open for the sale of liquor; or

sell any liquor or permit or suffer any liquor to be drunk or consumed in or upon the licensed premises;

upon

(a) Anzac Day, the 25th day of April; or Good Friday; or Christmas Day;

> whether those respective days fall on a Sunday or any other day of the week;

(b) Sunday-

except during two periods, one of which shall be between 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. and the other of which shall be between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. and then only during either period if the liquor is sold otherwise than by the bottle or in a bottle;

(c) any day of the week, other than a day mentioned in the foregoing subparagraphs(a) and(b), except between 9 a.m. and11 p.m.

(5) This Proclamation does not prejudice the operation in the Coolgardie Licensing District and the Kanowna Licensing District of the provisions of the Licensing Act, 1911-1956, relating to the holders of licenses other than publicans' general licenses, hotel licenses and wayside-house licenses or contained in section 44 and in subsection (3) of section 121 and in paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (2) of section 122 of that Act.

Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 980/57.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Water Supply Improvements. Belmont Park, Bayswater, and Perth Road Districts.

Proposed Victoria Park-Mt. Yokine 42-Inch Trunk Main.

Second Section—Belmont to Mt. Yokine Reservoir.

The laying of a 42-inch diameter steel water main (length approximately six miles) together with the installation of valves and all other necessary apparatus connected therewith, as shown in red on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 8215.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 24th day of April, 1958.
