WHEREAS by sections 223 and 225 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1956 (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the City of Perth Municipal Council has requested that certain land named and described in the Schedule hereunder which has been reserved for a street or way within the Municipality of Perth, be declared a public highway: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said land to be a public highway, and such land shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 10th day of September, 1958, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

C.S.D. 305/58.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 5 of the Fire Brigades Act, 1942-1951, that the municipal and road districts mentioned in the Second Schedule to the Act are, for the purposes of the Act, constituted fire districts, by the names as in the said Schedule stated and that the Governor may, by Order in Council, constitute the district of any other local authority a fire district; assign a name to any such district; and include the same in Part II, or Part III, or Part IV of the Second Schedule; and whereas it is further enacted by that section that the Governor may, by Order in Council, excise from any fire district any specified portion thereof, and thereupon such portion shall, for the purposes of the Act, be no longer included in or be part of such district: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Act, doth hereby—

- (a) constitute the Darling Range Road District a fire district;
- (b) assign the name of Kalamunda Fire District to that district; and
- (c) excise from the Kalamunda Fire District all that portion of land set out in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

All the land contained within the boundaries of the Darling Range Road District with the exception of all that portion of land, bounded by lines starting from a point on the western boundary of Canning Location 2639, situate in prolongation easterly of the southern side of Jessie Street and extending southerly along that boundary to the northern side of Hill Street (road number 10683); thence easterly along that side to the eastern boundary of location 2639 aforesaid; thence southerly along that boundary and the western boundary of location 1473 and onwards to and along the easternmost boundary of Kalamunda Townsite Lot 419 (reserve 23277) to the south-eastern corner of that lot; thence south-westerly to the westernmost corner of lot 361 (reserve 19232); thence generally south-easterly along the north-eastern side of Byron Road and onwards to the southern side of Howell Road; thence easterly along the northern boundaries of Canning Locations 395 and 563 to the north-eastern corner of the latter location; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of that location and onwards to the north-eastern side of the late Upper Darling Range Railway Reserve; thence generally south-easterly along that side and the south-western side of road number 6547 to a point situate north of the intersection of the eastern side of Caladenia Road and the prolongation easterly of the northern side of Banksia Road; thence south to that intersection; thence westerly to and along the northern side of Banksia Road aforesaid and onwards to the western side of Canning Road (road number 1837); thence southerly along that side to the southern side of Glyde Road (road number 6352); thence generally westerly along southern sides of Glyde Road (road numbers 6852 and 7412) and onwards to and along the southern boundary of Kalamunda Townsite Lot 360 and onwards to the

south-eastern corner of lot 176; thence northerly, north-easterly and westerly along boundaries of that lot to its north-western corner; thence northerly to and along the western boundary of lot 177 and onwards to the southern boundary of lot 180 (reserve 23383); thence westerly along that boundary and to and along the southern boundaries of lot 179 (reserve 24240) to its south-western corner; thence northerly along its western boundary and onwards to the south-eastern corner of lot 102 of Canning Location 579 as shown on Lands Titles Office Deposited Plan 3609; thence westerly and north-easterly along boundaries of that lot to the south-western corner of location 259; thence northerly along the western boundaries of that location and of locations 80, 422, 929 and onwards to the southern boundary of location 244; thence westerly, northerly and easterly along boundaries of that location to the south-western corner of location 398; thence northerly along the easternmost boundary of Swan Location 1394, the eastern boundary of lot 47 of Canning Location 437, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 2551, to the north-eastern corner of that lot; thence north-north-westerly to the south-eastern corner of lot 20 of that location; thence northerly and westerly along boundaries of that lot to the south-eastern corner of Swan Location 4141; thence northerly and north-westerly along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the western boundary of lot 4 of location 1304 as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 2764; thence northerly and easterly to and along the western and northern boundaries of that lot to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the western boundary of lot 23 of location 1304; thence northerly to and along the western boundaries of that lot and of lots 22 to 18 inclusive and the western boundary of location 1378 to the north-western corner of that location; thence north-north-easterly to the western corner of lot 19 of location 1763 as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 4551; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of that lot and of lots 20 to 23 inclusive and onwards to a point situate west of the north-western corner of lot 2 of Kalamunda Townsite Lot 185 as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Diagram 4676; thence east to the western side of William Street; thence generally north-easterly along that side and the western side of Lascelles Parade to a point situate in prolongation westerly of the southern side of Jessie Street aforesaid and thence easterly to and along that side and onwards to the starting point. (Public Plans Kalamunda Regional Sheets 1 and 2, South Kalamunda Townsite, 1 C20, N.W., and 1 C20, S.W., Walliston Townsite.)

ORDERS IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS by section 33 of the Land Act, 1933-1956, it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any municipality, road board, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in section 29 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order, and with power of subleasing; and whereas it is deemed expedient as follows:—

Corr. No. 3644/27.—That reserve 19757 (Tambellup Lot 290) should vest in and be held by the Tambellup Road Board in trust for Greater Sports Ground and Community Centre.

(The previous Order in Council dated 3rd April, 1928, respecting this Reserve is hereby superseded.)

Corr. No. 3153/06.—That reserve 10921 should vest in and be held by the Carnarvon Municipal Council in trust for Kindergarten Site.

(The previous Order in Council issued under Executive Council Minute No. 824, dated 1st May, 1958, respecting this Reserve is hereby cancelled.)

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the beforementioned reserves shall vest in and be held by the abovementioned bodies in trust for the purposes aforesaid with power to the said bodies, subject to the approval in writing of the Minister for Lands being first obtained, to lease the whole or any portion of the said reserves for any term not exceeding 21 years from the date of the lease.

ORDER-IN-COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, have power to construct, provide, and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Lieutenant Governor and Administrator in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Water Supply Improvements.
City of Fremantle and Canning and Melville Road Districts.

Proposed 24-inch and 14-inch Water Main.
First Section—High Road, Riverton, to Melville Avenue, Brentwood.

(a) The laying of a 24-inch nominal diameter steel water main, concrete lined, and enamel coated (length approximately three and three-eighths miles), together with the installation of valves and all other necessary apparatus connected therewith.

(b) The laying of a 14-inch nominal diameter steel water main, concrete lined, and enamel coated (length approximately seven-eighths of a mile), together with the installation of valves and all other necessary apparatus connected therewith.

The above works are shown in red on Plan M.W.S.S. and D.D., W.A., No. 8216.

This Order-in-Council shall take effect from the 19th day of September, 1958.

The above works to be complete with valves and hydrants, and all necessary apparatus.

4. The clearing of all inflammable material between the boundary of the property and any constructed road bounding the property shall be deemed to be a sufficient firebreak for that boundary in lieu of firebreaks required in paragraphs 1 (b) and 2 (b) above.

5.
