WHEREAS by the Election of Senators Act, 1903, it is provided that the Governor may, by Proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette* not less than seven days before the issue of the writ for any election of Senators for the State of Western Australia, fix the places at which such election shall be held, and the dates for the nomination, the polling, and the declaration of the poll and return of the writ; and whereas Wednesday, the 22nd day of October, 1958, has been fixed as the date for the issue of a writ for the election of Senators aforesaid: Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby fix Friday, the 31st day of October, 1958, at 12 o'clock noon, as the day and time before which nominations for the said election are to be made, and Saturday, the 22nd day of November, 1958, as the date for the polling at the said election, and on or before Tuesday, the 20th day of January, 1959, as the date for the return of the writ; and do hereby fix the office of the Commonwealth Electoral Officer, Commonwealth Bank Buildings, Murray Street, Perth, as the place of nomination for the said election, and the polling places within the said State appointed under the law of the Commonwealth for the time being in force for the regulation of Parliamentary elections as the places at which such election shall be held.

CORR. 3091/58 (L. & S.)

WHEREAS by sections 223 and 225 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1956 (6 Edward, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the City of Perth has requested that certain lands named and described in the Schedule hereunder which have been reserved for streets within the City of Perth, be declared public highways: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said land to be public highways, and such lands shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as highways within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

Schedule.

All those roads as surveyed and shown coloured brown on Land and Titles Office Plans 5153 and 5280 (but excluding all rights-of-way of a lesser width than 100 links) and comprising:—

Challenger Drive, Lowanna Way, Elouera Way, Kingsland Avenue, Hesperia Avenue, Hovea Crescent, Boronia Crescent, Elimatta Way, Templetonia Crescent and Dampier Avenue.

Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1956.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

L.G. 229/58.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 338A of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1956, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, prescribe uniform general regulations with respect to all or any of the matters in relation to which a council may make by-laws under section 338 of the Act; and whereas it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 38 of the Interpretation Act, 1918-1957, that power given by any Act to make regulations, rules, or by-laws shall be deemed to include power from time to time to revoke the same absolutely, in whole or in part; and whereas by Order in Council issued on the 30th July, 1958, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 18th August, 1958, uniform general regulations, entitled Uniform General Building Regulations, were so prescribed and are in force in the municipal districts for the time being constituted under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1956; and whereas it is deemed advisable and expedient to revoke the Uniform General

Building Regulations: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1956, and the Interpretation Act, 1918-1957, do hereby revoke the Order in Council issued on the 30th July, 1958, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 18th August, 1958, and the Uniform General Building Regulations set out in the Schedule thereto.

constituted under the Road Districts Act, 1919-1956, and specified in the Schedule "B" to that Order in Council; and whereas it is deemed advisable and expedient to revoke the Uniform General Building By-laws: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred by the Road Districts Act, 1919-1956, and the Interpretation Act, 1918-1957, doth hereby revoke the Order in Council issued on the 30th July, 1958, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 18th August, 1958, and the Uniform General Building By-laws set out in the Schedule "B" thereto.

The net costs of the scheme (after crediting to the scheme the sale of surplus lots), including administration, survey, road construction and drainage, compensation (where owners do not accept a replacement lot or lots), and any other expenses incidental to the scheme, shall be divided among the owners of the lots which were originally capable of subdivision.
