WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by subsection (3) of section 14 of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders Act, 1921-1958, that where the Governor is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made or are about to be made by the legislature of any part of the Queen's Dominions or of any other country or other competent authority, for the enforcement within that part or that country of maintenance orders made by courts within this State, the Governor may, by Order in Council, extend the Act to that part or that country; and whereas it is further enacted by subsection (7) of section 14 of the Act that the Governor may by Order in Council extend the Act to any other country with such modification (if any) as the Governor may by the same or any other Order in Council declare; and whereas the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator is satisfied that such reciprocal provisions have been made by the legislature of India and that the provisions of the Act may be extended to India without modification: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby extend the provisions of the Act to India.
