WHEREAS subsection (2) of section 121 of the Licensing Act, 1911-1956, is as follows:—

(2) No licensee shall in the Goldfields district—

- (a) have or keep his licensed premises open for the sale of liquor; or
- (b) sell any liquor or permit or suffer any liquor to be drunk or consumed in or upon his licensed premises,

at any time before nine o'clock in the morning or after eleven o'clock at night upon any day in the week, except under the authority of an occasional license.

Penalty: For the first offence, Fifty Pounds; for any subsequent offence, One hundred pounds;

Provided that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Licensing Court by proclamation extend or reduce the hours in any licensing district or part of a district within the Goldfields district, and this subsection shall have effect as so modified, but any such proclamation may, on the recommendation of the Licensing Court, be varied or revoked by a subsequent proclamation.

And whereas by a Proclamation dated the 23rd November, 1953, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 27th November, 1953, the hours were extended in respect of publicans' general licenses, hotel licenses and way-side house licenses in the districts within the Goldfields District specified in the Second Schedule to that Proclamation; and whereas the Licensing Court on the 28th August, 1958, made a recommendation to the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator in respect of the hours of trading on a Sunday within the

Gascoyne Licensing District: Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Licensing Court, do hereby vary the Proclamation dated the 23rd November, 1953, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 27th November, 1953, by substituting for the passage, "Gascoyne Licensing District—12 noon to 1 p.m.; 5 p.m. to 6 p.m." appearing in the Second Schedule to that Proclamation the passage, "Gascoyne Licensing District—11.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.; 5 p.m. to 6 p.m."

- (a) have or keep his licensed premises open for the sale of liquor; or
- (b) sell any liquor or permit or suffer any liquor to be drunk or consumed in or upon his licensed premises,

at any time before nine o'clock in the morning or after eleven o'clock at night upon any day in the week, except under the authority of an occasional license.

Penalty: For the first offence, Fifty Pounds; for any subsequent offence, One hundred pounds;

Provided that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Licensing Court by proclamation extend or reduce the hours in any licensing district or part of a district within the Goldfields district, and this subsection shall have effect as so modified, but any such proclamation may, on the recommendation of the Licensing Court, be varied or revoked by a subsequent proclamation.

And whereas by a Proclamation dated the 7th May, 1952, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 16th May, 1952, the hours were extended in respect of publicans' general licenses, hotel licenses and way-side house licenses in specified districts within the Goldfields District and by a Proclamation dated the 17th April, 1958, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 24th April, 1958, were extended in respect of those licenses within the Coolgardie and Kanowna Licensing District; and whereas the Licensing Court on the 28th August, 1958, made a recommendation to the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator in respect of those hours: Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Licensing Court do hereby vary the Proclamation dated the 17th April, 1958, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 24th April, 1958, by substituting for the passage, "3 p.m. and 6 p.m." in line five of subparagraph (b) of paragraph (4) the passage, "3.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m."

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown lands as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) the Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation;
- (b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament, the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council, revoke such dedication.

Amendment to Serpentine-Mundijong Drainage District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 753/50.

WHEREAS by section 12 of the Land Drainage Act, 1925-1954, it is provided that the Governor may, at any time, by Order in Council extend any district by the addition thereto of any land that has not theretofore formed part of a district: Now,

therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby vary and amend the boundaries of the Serpentine-Mundijong Drainage District by adding thereto the whole of the land as described in the Schedule hereto.

Addition to the Serpentine-Mundijong Drainage District.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the northernmost corner of Cockburn Sound Location 22, a point on the present Serpentine-Mundijong Drainage District boundary and extending generally east-south-easterly and southerly along boundaries of that location to its south-eastern corner; thence easterly, southerly and westerly along boundaries of location 326 to the north-eastern corner of location 422; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of that location to the northern boundary of location 426; thence easterly, southerly and westerly along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of location 23; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the south-eastern corner of that location and onwards southerly, easterly, again southerly and generally west-north-westerly to and along boundaries of location 407 to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of location 653; thence westerly to and along that boundary to the north-eastern corner of location 454; thence southerly and generally westerly along boundaries of that location to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of Serpentine Agricultural Area Lot 59; thence southerly to and along that boundary and westerly along the southern boundary of that lot to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of Cockburn Sound Location 160; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the northern boundary of location 397; thence easterly and southerly along boundaries of that location to its south-eastern corner and southerly and westerly along boundaries of location 396 to the north-western corner of location 248; thence southerly along the western boundary of that location to its south-western corner; thence southerly and westerly along boundaries of location 395 to a north-eastern corner of Serpentine Agricultural Area Lot 81, a point on the western side of road number 8313; thence southerly and generally west-south-westerly along boundaries of lot 81 to the north-eastern corner of lot 82; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of that lot and that of lot 85 to a south-eastern corner of the last mentioned lot; thence westerly, southerly and again westerly along boundaries of that lot to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of Cockburn Sound Location 27; thence southerly to and along that boundary to the right bank of the Serpentine River; thence westerly downwards along that bank to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of location 39; thence southerly to and along that boundary and westerly along the southern boundary of that location to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of location 628; thence southerly to and along that boundary and boundaries of location 629 and Serpentine Townsite Lots 64 and 65 to the northern side of road number 1887; thence generally east-south-easterly along that side to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of lot 66; thence southerly to and along that boundary and that of lot 67 to the northern boundary of Cockburn Sound Location 555; thence easterly and generally south-westerly along boundaries of that location to its southernmost corner; thence south-easterly to the south-western corner of location 564; thence easterly along the southern boundary of that location to the north-eastern corner of location 475; thence southerly and westerly along boundaries of that location to the north-eastern corner of location 491; thence southerly and westerly along boundaries of that location and onwards to the western side of the South-Western Highway; thence generally southerly along that side to a

point situate in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of location 474; thence easterly and generally southerly along boundaries of that location to the northern boundary of location 1157; thence easterly, southerly and westerly along boundaries of that location to the north-eastern corner of location 298; thence southerly and westerly along boundaries of that location and onwards to the eastern boundary of location 251; thence generally southerly along that boundary and onwards to the northern boundary of Keysbrook Townsite; thence westerly along that boundary to the western side of the South-Western Railway Reserve, a point on the present boundary of the Serpentine-Mundijong Drainage District; and thence generally northerly along that boundary to the starting point, as delineated and shown bordered red on Department of Lands and Surveys Miscellaneous Plan Number 222, and Plan P.W.D., W.A. 36366.

Traffic Act, 1919-1957.

Koorda Road Board.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Police T./O. 58/430.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order under section 49 of the Traffic Act, 1919-1957, namely, that the Koorda Road Board is hereby empowered to make by-laws in pursuance of—

- (1) clause (a) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, prescribing the rules to be observed in respect of any vehicle being driven or used on roads, and the use of footpaths;
- (2) clause (y) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, providing for the placing, erection or installation on roads or footpaths of traffic signs, lights and directions for the control and direction of traffic, both vehicular and pedestrian, and including the driving of animals, for the marking on roads or footpaths of signs for the control and direction of the traffic and for the regulation and prohibition of the traffic in relation to the signs, lights and directions;
- (3) clause (zd) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, appointing stands and parking places for different classes of vehicles and regulates the use thereof;

- (4) clauses (zl) and (zm) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, prohibiting or restricting the parking of vehicles or vehicles of a specified class or classes in all roads or in specified roads, or specified parts of roads, at all times or at specified times, and prescribing a penalty for any breach thereof;

subject to the condition that no such by-law shall be valid and effectual unless it has prior to notification of its making being published in the *Government Gazette*, been submitted to and approved by the Governor.
