I, THE said Lieutenant-Governor and Adminis-trator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby further amend the Commission given to you by His Excellency the Governor and under the Public Seal of the said State on the 19th day of June, 1957, and amended by Commission given to you by me as Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator under the Public Seal of the said State on the 13th day of August, 1958, by inserting after paragraph (d) of the subject matter of the inquiry to be made by you a new paragraph, to stand as paragraph (e), as follows: paragraph, to stand as paragraph (e), as follows:-

(e) Road services in the Lakes area of West-ern Australia particularly in regard to the payment of subsidies therefor.

For the purposes of this Commission, the expression "the Lakes area" means the area which has-

- (a) as its northern boundary an imagin-ary straight line running from Hyden due east to a point intersecting with the No. 1 Rabbit-proof Fence;
- (b) as its eastern boundary from the said point south-easterly along the said fence to its junction with the main Jerramungup-Esperance Road;
- (c) as its southern boundary the said road from the said junction westerly to a point due south from Newdegate; and

(d) as its western boundary imaginary straight lines running from Newdegate to Hyden and due south from Newdegate to the said road.

And the said Commission as amended shall be read and construed accordingly.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Fauna Protection Act, 1950-1954, I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare as follows:

- (1) That the period from 6 o'clock in the after-noon of 20th December, 1958, to 30th April, 1959, shall be an open season in respect of wild ducks in that part of the State which lies within the boundaries of the road districts specified in the First Schedule hereto, with the exception of those areas defined in the Second Schedule hereto.
- (2) That the period from 5 o'clock in the fore-noon of 21st December, 1958, to 30th April, 1958, to 30th April, 1959, shall be an open reason in respect of wild ducks in those parts of the State which lie within the boundaries of the South-West and Eucla Divisions as de-fined in section 28 of the Land Act, 1933 with the exceptions of those areas defined in the First and Second Schedules hereto
- (3) That a person shall not take any wild duck or the egg or any wild duck for the purpose of keeping it in captivity, or fo the purpose of aviculture, or for the pur pose of sale.
- (4) That a person shall not sell any wild duck

(1) Assays, analyses and tests may be made of any Western Australian raw material or manufactured product by the Government Chemical Laboratories when not unduly interfering with official work, subject to the pre-payment of the fees set out below and the conditions laid down in para-graphs (4) and (6) hereunder. (2) Reductions of the usual fees will be allowed under certain conditions, viz.:—

(a) for a number of samples submitted by the one person at the one time for identical treatment:-

Five to ten (inclusive) $\dots 20\%$ reduction. Eleven or more $\dots 25\%$ reduction. A special reduced fee may be charged where the extra work involved in a number of samples is so small as to warrant a special fee.

(b) Agricultural materials, including waters, will be charged at one-third rates to persons who provide evidence that they are bona fide prospectors, farmers, market gardeners, orch-ardists, graziers or other primary producers (name of owner or occupier, location number of site of sample, etc.) and that the examina-tion is needed for the proper conduct of their tion is needed for the proper conduct of their business as such.

(c) At the discretion of the Director free mineral identifications and assays will be made mineral identifications and assays will be made for prospectors of Western Australian ores and minerals taken from ground not held under gold mining lease, mineral lease, dredging claim or mineral claim provided the exact locality where the specimen was found is disclosed.

Free assays will not be made of samples showing free gold, or of tailings or other metallurgical products or of umpire samples.

(3) A special fee will be charged for any ab-normal, lengthy or intricate investigation, in accordance with the actual cost to the Laboratories. This includes assays for the less commonly occurring elements.

(4) All samples for examination must be ad-dressed to the Director, Government Chemical Laboratories, Adelaide Terrace, Perth, and must be marked on the outside with the name and address of the sender. This information should also be be distinctly and separately marked. A letter must be sent at the same time stating the reasons why the sample is submitted and enclosing the prescribed fee, or, if applicable, stating the exact locality from which each mineral specimen was taken (paragraph 2c).

(5) Samples will normally be dealt with in order of their receival, at such times as do not interfere with Departmental work.

(6) The Director reserves the right to refuse to (6) The Director reserves the right to refuse to make any particular examination on the ground of (i) the laboratories being already too fully occu-pied to accept more samples; (ii) the sample being unsuitable for the purpose; or (iii) any other good and sufficient reason. He also reserves the right of publishing after the expiration of 12 months, the result of any assay or other investigation made at the public expense. the public expense.
