WHEREAS by section 28A of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1955, it is provided that where the Commissioner is of opinion that a controlled access road should be provided and should be entered and departed from at specified places only, he shall make a recommendation to the Governor accordingly and that if of opinion that the recommendation should be given effect the Governor may, by Proclamation, proclaim the controlled access road and the places only at which the controlled access road may be entered or departed from; and whereas the Commissioner is of opinion that a controlled access road should be provided as hereinafter described and should be entered and departed from at the places specified hereunder only and has made a recommendation to the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator accordingly; and whereas I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator of the said State, am of opinion that such recommendation should be given effect: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in

exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby proclaim that the parcels of land coloured green in Plan P.W.D., W.A. No. 33968, and which together are more particularly described in Schedule 1 hereto shall be a Controlled Access Road and that the places specified in Schedule 2 hereto shall be the only places at which such Controlled Access Road may be entered or departed from.

Schedule 2.

WHEREAS it is enacted, *inter alia*, by section 15 of the Wheat Products (Prices Fixation) Act, 1938-1939, that the Governor may from time to time, on the recommendation of the Wheat Products Prices Committee constituted pursuant to that Act, by Proclamation fix the minimum and the maximum price at which substances included in the definition of wheat products may be sold in the State, by the manufacturer thereof or by any person, and that the Governor may from time to time revoke or vary any Proclamation under the section by a subsequent Proclamation; and whereas the Governor by Proclamation dated the 19th day of December, 1957, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 20th day of December, 1957, as varied by a Proclamation dated the 16th day of July, 1958, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 25th day of July, 1958, fixed the prices at which bread, being a wheat product within the meaning of the Act, may be sold by any person in the various parts of the State specified in that Proclamation: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Wheat Products Prices Committee, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon me by the Act, do hereby further vary the Proclamation dated the 19th day of December, 1957, made pursuant to that Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 20th day of December, 1957, as so varied—
