Main Roads Act, 1930-1955 Declaration of Controlled Access Road.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Henry Gairdner, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor in and over the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by paragraphs (C) and (D) of section 28A of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1955, it is provided that where the Commissioner is of the John of the Imain Roads Act, 1930-1955, it is provided that where the Commissioner is of the opinion that a Proclamation made pursuant to section 28A of the Main Roads Act, 1930-1955, should be varied or cancelled he shall make a recommendation to the Governor accordingly and if of the opinion that the recommendation should be given effect the Governor may by subsequent Proclamation vary or cancel a former Proclamation; and whereas the Commissioner is of the opinion that a Proclamation should be so varied or cancelled as hereinafter described and has made a recommendation to the Governor accordingly; and recommendation to the Governor accordingly; and whereas I, the Governor of the said State, am of the opinion that such recommendation should be given effect: Now, therefore I, the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do proclaim that access will be permitted at points A and B and is prohibited at Points C, D, E and F, and which are more particularly described in Schedules 1 and 2 hereto respectively.

Schedule 1.

(a) That portion of the north-western boundary of Canning Location 707 starting from a point situate 6 chains 22 and 2/10ths links south-westerly from the northern corner of that location and extending south-westerly 2 chains 57 and 7/10ths links along that boundary.

(b) Portion of the northern side of Welshpool Road (road numbered 2773), starting from a point situate 318 degrees 40 minutes, 4 chains 19 and 7/10ths links from the south-eastern corner of the northern severance of Canning Location 478 and extending 243 degrees 45 minutes, 2 chains 88 and 7/10ths links along the northern side of Welshpool Road aforesaid, as shown on Department of Lands and Surveys Original Diagram 64365.

Schedule 2.

- (a) That portion of the northern alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the northern side of that Controlled Access Road and the north-western boundary of lot 5 on Canning Location 578 and extending 1 chain 28 and 9/10ths links across a one-chain road to an eastern corner of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid, situate 1 chain 59 and 3/10ths links north-easterly from the south-eastern corner of lot 6 of location 578 aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161.
- (b) That portion of the southern alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the north-western boun-dary of lot 2 of Canning Location 578 and the southern side of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid, and extending westerly in prolongation of that side across a one-chain road to the south-eastern boundary of lot 1 of location 578, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161.
- That portion of the northern alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the northern side of that Controlled Access Road and the south-eastern side of road number 10993 and extending westerly 1 chain 20 and 9/10ths links across that road to the intersection of the northern side of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid and the north-western side of road number 10993 aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161 7161.

- (b) That portion of the southern alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the southern side of that Controlled Access Road and the south-eastern side of road number 10993 and extending westerly 1 chain 20 and 8/10ths links across that road to the intersection of the southern side of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid and the northwestern side of road number 10993 aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161.
- 3. (a) That portion of the northern alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the northern side of that Controlled Access Road and the south-western boundary of lot 24 of Canning Location 578 and extending westerly across a one-chain road to the intersection of the north-eastern boundary of lot 12 of location 578 and the northern side of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161.
- (b) That portion of the southern alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the southern side of that Controlled Access Road and the south-western boundary of lot 24 of Canning Location 578 and extending westerly across a one-chain road to the intersection of the north-eastern boundary of lot 11 of location 578 and the southern side of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161.
- 4. (a) That portion of the north-eastern alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the north-eastern side of that Controlled Access Road and the north-western boundary of lot 20 of Canning Location 706 and extending north-westerly 1 chain and 6/10ths links across a one-chain road to the intersection of the south-eastern boundary of lot 25 of location 578 and the north-eastern side of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161.
- (b) That portion of the south-western alignment of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road starting from the intersection of the south-western side of that Controlled Access Road and the north-western boundary of lot 44 of Canning Location 706 and extending north-westerly across a one-chain road to the intersection of the south-eastern boundary of lot 25 of location 578 and the south-western side of the Welshpool Controlled Access Road aforesaid, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 7161.

Land Act, 1933-1958. ORDERS IN COUNCIL.

Rights in Water and Irrigation Act, 1914-1951.

Extension of Collie River Irrigation District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 348/45.

WHEREAS by section 29 of the Rights in Water and Irrigation Act, 1914-1951, it is provided that the Governor on the recommendation of the Minister, acting with the advice of the Commissioners appointed under the said Act, may by Order in Council, amongst other things, extend any Irrigation District by the addition thereto of any land that has not heretofore formed part of a district: Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, on the recommendation of the Minister, acting with the advice of the said Commissioners, doth hereby extend the Collie River Irrigation District by adding thereto the area described in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

Extension of Collie River Irrigation District.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting at the intersection of the left bank of the Mornington River and the western boundary of lot 37 of Wellington Location 1, as shown on Lands Titles Office Plan 3466, a point on the boundary of Collie River Irrigation District and extending north-north-easterly along the western boundary of lot 37 aforesaid to the south-western corner of lot 38, a point on a southern boundary of the Harvey Irrigation District; thence generally east-south-easterly along that boundary to a point situate at the intersection of the prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of lot 31, shown on Lands Titles Office Plan 3466 and the prolongation south-south-westerly of the eastern boundary of lot 37, shown on Lands Titles Office Plan 839; thence south-south-westerly to the north-eastern corner of lot 23, as shown on Plan 839 aforesaid; thence south-south-westerly along the eastern boundaries of that lot and lots 21, 19, 17, 15, 13, 11 and 9 to the northern boundary of lot 37, as shown on Lands Titles Office Diagram 1087; thence easterly along that boundary about 25 chains to a northern boundary of the Collie River Irrigation District; thence south-westerly and north-westerly along boundaries of that Part, to a point situate at the intersection of the western side of the South-Western Railway Reserve and the prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Brunswick Estate Lot 17, a point on the boundary of Collie River Irrigation District aforesaid; thence northerly, westerly and again northerly along boundaries of that part to the starting point, as shown on Lands and Surveys Department Miscellaneous Plan No. 232 and on Plan P.W.D., W.A. 36564.
