WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 165 of the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-1957, that the Governor may from time to time by Pro-clamation exempt any portion of the State from the operation of the Act, or any Part thereof: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, do by this Proclamation exempt that portion of the State which is comprised within the limits of the Royal Agricultural Society Showgrounds at Claremont established by the Royal Agricultural Society Act, 1926, as amended, from the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-1957, except the provisions relating to Industrial Awards and Agreements and to the

duties of Industrial Inspectors, for the periods from the 9th to the 11th April, 1959, inclusive, and the 13th to the 18th April, 1959, inclusive.


