IN Pursuance of the provisions of section 10 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1956, I, the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever, by means of more than two fish traps other than crayfish pots, in that portion of Western Australian waters lying South of 28 deg. 15 min. of South latitude, and West of 114 deg. 10 min. of East longitude, including the waters surrounding the islands situated therein, for a period of five years from April 1, 1959.
