WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of section 17 of the Charitable Collections Act, 1946-1949, the sum of £9,653 6s. 7d. is vested in Ross Hutchinson as the Minister of the Crown to whom for the time being the administration of the said Act is committed and is held by him on trust for the promotion of the objects of the Community Youth Centre (hereinafter called "the Association") as set out in the Constitution and Rules thereof; and whereas by the provisions of section 17 (2) of the said Act the Governor may, by Proclamation, vary the trusts and may, by the same Proclamation, vest the said moneys in such persons and for such charitable purposes as the Governor shall specify; and whereas financial assistance towards the erection, establishment, equipment, carrying on, maintenance and improvement of a community youth centre at the John Curtin High School, Fremantle, for use by such charitable or social welfare organisations which have been or are affiliated with the Association is a charitable purpose within the meaning of the said Act; and whereas the Governor has specified that the said sum shall now vest in the Minister for Works for that charitable purpose: Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby vest the said moneys in the Minister for Works for the charitable purpose of financial assistance to the extent of £8,000 towards the erection of a community youth centre at the John Curtin High School, Fremantle, for use by such charitable or social welfare organisations which have been or are affiliated with the Association and for the charitable purpose of establishing, equipping, carrying on, maintenance and improvement of the said centre financial assistance to the extent of the balance of the said sum of £1,653 6s. 7d.

WHEREAS by section 31 of the Land Act, 1933-1958, the Governor may, by Proclamation, and subject to such conditions as may be expressed therein, classify as of Class "A" any lands of the Crown reserved to Her Majesty for any of the purposes specified in the said section; and whereas it is deemed expedient that the reserve described in the schedule hereto should be classified as of Class "A": Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation classify as of Class "A" the reserve described in the schedule hereto.

Schedule.

Reserve No. 25373 containing about 3,430 acres being the whole of the land comprised in Sussex Location 4167 and containing about 2,730 acres, bounded by lines starting at a point on the left bank of the Blackwood River situate in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of location 4072 and extending easterly to the north-western corner of that location; thence generally south-easterly along south-western boundaries of that location to survey mark V.1; thence 179 degrees 44 minutes, 1 chain to the southern side of a one chain road passing along southern boundaries of locations 4072 aforesaid and 2484; thence easterly 32 chains 45 and nine-tenths links along that side to the western side of a one-chain road; thence generally south-south-easterly along that side and western sides of a one-chain road passing along the western boundaries of locations 2498, 2499, 2500, 2742, 2743, 2986, 2968 and 2967 to a point situate in prolongation north-westerly of the south-western boundary of location 2967 aforesaid; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to a point situate 35 chains 23 and seven-tenths links from the western corner of that location; thence 34 degrees 53 minutes, 27 chains 31 and seven-tenths links to the north-eastern boundary of that location; thence 64 degrees 49 minutes, 27 chains 61 and six-tenths links to an eastern boundary of location 2968; thence 94 degrees 14 minutes, 45 chains 24 and four-tenths links to the eastern boundary of Location 2969; thence 130 degrees 24 minutes, 41 chains 13 and two-tenths links across a one-chain road and onwards to a point on the eastern boundary of location 2970 situate 51 chains 40 and nine-tenths links from the north-eastern corner of that location; thence southerly along the prolongation of the eastern boundary of that location to the right bank of the Scott River; thence generally south-westerly along that bank to its junction with the left bank of the Blackwood River and thence generally northerly along that bank to the starting point; and the whole of the land comprised in Sussex Location 4166 and containing about 700 acres bounded by lines starting at a point on a southern shore of Hardy Inlet situate in prolongation northerly of the western boundary of location 2985 and extending generally north-easterly upwards along that shore and the left bank of Scott River to a point situate in prolongation northerly of the eastern boundary of location 2976; thence southerly to and along that boundary to a point situate 35 chains 67 and five-tenths links from the south-eastern corner of that location; thence 288 degrees 33 minutes, 27 chains 65 and one-tenth links to the eastern boundary of location 2977; thence 300 degrees 9 minutes, 28 chains 65 and three-tenths links to the eastern boundary of location 2978; thence 275 degrees 24 minutes, 22 chains 10 and one-tenth links to and across a one-chain road to the eastern boundary of location 2979; thence 304 degrees 6 minutes, 28 chains; thence 255 degrees 41 minutes, 26 chains 51 and eight-tenths links to the north-eastern boundary of location 2980; thence 202 degrees 57 minutes, 46 chains 12 and five-tenths links to the north-eastern boundary

of location 2981; thence 194 degrees 25 minutes, 30 chains; thence 194 degrees 17 minutes, 12 chains 76 and four-tenths links to a northern corner of location 2982 situate 50 chains 8 and three-tenths links from its eastern corner; thence 234 degrees 48 minutes, 50 chains 88 and one-tenth links to the north-eastern boundary of location 2983; thence 235 degrees 54 minutes, 23 chains 42 and six-tenths links to the north-eastern boundary of location 2984; thence 234 degrees 50 minutes, 26 chains 48 and five-tenths links to the north-eastern boundary of location 2985; thence 234 degrees 41 minutes, 22 chains 45 and seven-tenths links to a point on the western boundary of that location situate 37 chains 46 and five-tenths links from its southern corner and thence northerly along that boundary and onwards to the starting point. WHEREAS it is enacted by section 5 of the Road Districts Act, 1919, that for the purposes of the Act the word "Town" or "Townsite" means and includes, *inter alia*, any land (including privately owned subdivided land) which the Governor may see fit as he is thereby empowered to declare, by Proclamation, to be a town or townsite for the purposes of the Act; and whereas all that land situated within the Swan Road District, more particularly described in the Schedule hereunder, is land which the Governor may by virtue of section 5 of the Act declare, by Proclamation, to be a town or townsite for the purposes of the Act: Now, therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Road Districts Act, 1919, and of all other powers in this behalf enabling me, do hereby declare that all that land situated within the Swan Road District, more particularly described in the Schedule hereto, shall be a townsite, to be known as "Hazelmere," within the meaning and for the purposes of the Road Districts Act, 1919.

Hazelmere Townsite.

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from the intersection of the south-western side of Hervey Avenue and the western side of Janet Street, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 5212, and extending northerly along the western side of the lastmentioned street and onwards to the northern side of Swan Street; thence generally east-south-easterly along northern sides of that street and Stirling Crescent to a point situate in prolongation north-westerly of the north-eastern side of Eric Street; thence south-easterly to and along that side and onwards along the north-eastern boundary of lot 149 to its eastern corner; thence south-westerly along the north-western boundary of lot 58, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 4539, to its western corner; thence southerly to the northern corner of lot 83; thence south-south-westerly along the north-western boundary of that lot to its south-western corner; thence west-north-westerly and southerly along boundaries of lot 93 of Swan Location 16 and Helena Location

20a, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 4553, to its south-western corner; thence southerly to the northernmost corner of lot 125; thence south-westerly along its north-western boundary and the north-western boundary of lot 126 to a point situate in prolongation southerly of the western boundary of lot 5, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Diagram 15756; thence northerly to and along that boundary and western boundaries of lots 1 to 4 inclusive to the south-eastern corner of lot 86, as shown on Land Titles Office Deposited Plan 4539; thence north-north-westerly and south-westerly along boundaries of that lot to a point situate in prolongation south-easterly of the south-western side of Hervey Avenue aforesaid and thence north-westerly to and along that side to the starting point. Traffic Act, 1919-1958.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Police T.O. 59/580.

WHEREAS by virtue of section 71 of the Traffic Act, 1919-1958, that Act and regulations made thereunder apply, *inter alia*, to persons and vehicles in the public service of the Crown, or of any local authority, but do not apply to any vehicle or class of vehicle or person or class of person to the extent of such exemption as may from time to time be declared by the Governor by Order

in Council; Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 71 of the Act, doth hereby declare that the classes of vehicles specified in the Schedule hereto, when used in the service of the Crown or of any local authority, are exempt from the operation of all regulations in force and made from time to time under the provisions of the Act relating to brakes, lamps and lighting equipment except those regulations relating to any reflector or reflectors with which a vehicle is required to be equipped when used on a road.

Collie Coalfields Road Board.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Police T.O. 58/1123.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following Order under section 49 of the Traffic Act, 1919-1958, namely that the Collie Coalfields Road Board is hereby empowered to make by-laws in pursuance of—

- (1) clause (a) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, prescribing the rules to be observed in respect to any vehicle being driven or used on roads;
- (2) clause (y) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, providing for the placing, erection or installation on roads or footpaths of traffic signs, lights and directions for the control and direction of traffic, both vehicular and pedestrian and including the driving of animals, for the marking on roads or footpaths of signs for the control and direction of the traffic and for the regulation and prohibition of the traffic in relation to the signs, lights and directions;
- (3) clause (zd) of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, appointing stands and parking places for different classes of vehicles and regulate the use thereof;
- (4) clauses (zl) and (zm) of paragraph (1) of subsection (1) of section 47 of the said Act, prohibiting or restricting the parking of vehicles, or vehicles of a specified class or classes in all roads or in specified roads, or specified parts of roads, at all times or at specified times, and prescribing a penalty for any breach thereof;

subject to the condition that no such by-law shall be valid and effectual unless it has, prior to notification of its making being published in the *Government Gazette*, been submitted to and approved by the Governor.

Drainage Act, 1909-1956.

WHEREAS by The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower

the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

City of Perth—East Victoria Park and Perth South.

STATEMENT setting forth in detail an explanation and description of the several purposes of the Town Planning Scheme as shown on City Engineer's Plan No. 1547B and marked—

Preliminary Plan—Plan No. 2.

1.—Purpose of the Scheme:

The purpose of this minor town planning scheme is to re-plan, re-subdivide and zone the area within the Municipality of the City of Perth known as Smith's Lake, being part Swan Location 112 and contained within the area margined blue on City Engineer's Plan No. 1547A and marked "Civic Survey Plan—Plan No. 1."

2.—General Description:

The several proposals of the scheme may be generally described as follows:—

- (a) To reclaim to a suitable level the low-lying swamp area known as Smith's Lake and re-plan the adjacent area thereto, comprising in all approximately 51 acres.
- (b) To re-plan the scheme area in order to eliminate a number of subdivisional lots of unsatisfactory size and shape and re-subdivide the area and provide and zone allotments for residential and commercial purposes and certain areas for recreational purposes and for parking.
- (c) To construct approximately 20 chains of drains for the disposal of subsoil water in the area between Bourke and Albert Streets.
- (d) To eliminate certain rights of way and provide for new streets, the closure of certain existing streets and the extension of others.
- (e) To fix a new alignment along the Charles Street frontage of the scheme area for the purpose of widening Charles Street on the western side by approximately 12 feet.

Explanation of Scheme.

3.—Area:

The scheme area comprises 51 acres approximately, 26 acres of which lie below the level of R.L. 51.00 which is considered to be the lowest level suitable for residential purposes and for recreational development.

4.—Reclamation:

It is proposed to reclaim the central portion of the scheme area to approximately R.L. 51.00 for recreation and parking by filling with suitable material the low-lying area.

5.—New Streets:

New streets will be formed at approximately R.L. 52.00 and new allotments provided not lower than this level for residential purposes.

6.—Exchange or Sale of Re-planned Allotments:

Re-planned allotments will be made available, as far as possible, to the original land owners within the Scheme area, either by sale or exchange,

at a price consistent with the resumption or acquisition price of the land plus a proportionate cost of the Scheme plus the amount of rates that would have been payable during the period the land is held for the purpose of the Scheme.

Costs involved in the creation of the open spaces in the Scheme and of the construction of roads which are not necessary for the creation of new lots, will not be added to the value of the land negotiated with the original owners.

Balloting may be necessary to determine the disposal of lots where existing land owners have equal rights.

Other subdivided allotments will be exchanged at valuation or sold to existing land owners.

7.—Drainage:

The Scheme provides for the construction of 20 chains of stormwater drain which will permit the disposal of the subsoil water in the area between Bourke Street and Albert Street, and will also permit the disposal of stormwater run-off from the new road reserves, the stormwater drainage system to be connected to the existing main drain.

8.—Re-Planning:

The existing subdivision comprises 68 lots together with reservations for 11.3 chains of street and 12.9 chains of rights-of-way. Many of the existing lots are of excessive depth for use as building allotments. The proposed re-subdivision provides for the elimination of unnecessary rights-of-way and the re-casting of the area into 85 lots of suitable size for building purposes, one lot (162) for future subdivision for commercial and public buildings, 21 acres approximately for recreational reserves, one lot of approximately one acre for special purposes, and reservations for approximately 80 chains of street.

9.—Zoning:

The Scheme provides for the zoning of the Scheme area and classifying lots for commercial and residential purposes, and reserves. Eighty lots will be zoned for residential purposes, five lots for commercial purposes, one lot for commercial and communal facilities and seven lots for communal facilities.

10.—Responsible Authority:

In accordance with the provisions of the Town Planning and Development Act, 1928, section 8 (2) (b) the responsible authority for the Scheme is the Perth City Council.
