(1) IN pursuance of the provisions of section 10 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1956, I, the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever by means of fishing nets in those portions of Western Australian waters described in Schedules A, B, C and D hereto, for the term of five years from date of publication of this Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*.

(2) In pursuance of the provisions of the section aforesaid, I prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever by means of fishing nets in that portion of Western Australian waters described in Schedule E hereto, during the periods commencing at 8 o'clock in the afternoon of Thursday in each week and ending at 8 o'clock in the forenoon of the Sunday next following for the term of five years from date of publication of this Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*.

Schedules.

Schedule A.

All that portion of the waters of Leschenault Inlet bounded on the west by the railway bridge at Point MacLeod and on the east by a line of posts extending north-north-easterly from an unnamed point on the southern shore of the inlet, situate adjacent to and north-easterly from the mouth of the Preston River, to a point on the north-western shore of the inlet situate adjacent to the northern shore of the channel connecting the inlet to the sea. Being more particularly the portion of the Leschenault Inlet delineated and shown bordered red on Department of Lands and Surveys Miscellaneous Plan 248.

Schedule B.

The whole of the waters of the Collie River and all its tributaries and all that portion of Leschenault Inlet lying within a radius of 30 chains of the northernmost extremity of Bar Island.

Schedule C.

The whole of the coastal waters in the vicinity of Bunbury known as "Hungry Hollow," being those waters lying between the westerly extensions of Clifton Street and Beach Road, in the Municipality of Bunbury, and within a distance measured rectangularly from the foreshore of half a mile.

Schedule D.

The whole of the waters of that part of Koombana Bay lying within a radius of one-quarter of a mile of the groyne adjacent to the channel connecting Leschenault Inlet with the Indian Ocean.

Schedule E.

The whole of the waters of Leschenault Inlet lying to the north of a line drawn from a point marked by a post on the southern shore of the inlet situate adjacent to and north-easterly from the mouth of the Preston River to a point marked by a post on the north-western shore of the inlet situate adjacent to the northern shore of the channel connecting the inlet to the sea.

The Proclamation dated 9th February, 1956, and published in the *Government Gazette* (No. 18) of 24th February, 1956, is hereby revoked.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 1098/57.

WHEREAS by the Forests Act, 1918-1954, it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown Land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner:—

- (a) The Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation.
- (b) After such proposal has been laid before Parliament the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall, by Order in Council, revoke such dedication.

And whereas His Excellency the Governor did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the 16th day of October, 1957, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest; and whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest No. 51 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto.
