IN pursuance of the provisions of section 10 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1956, I, the Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby declare that all those portions of Western Australian waters described in the Schedule hereto shall be closed against the use of fishing nets for a period of five years from the date of publication hereof.

## Schedule.

All those portions of Shoalwater Bay, Warnbro Sound and the Indian Ocean bounded by a line 80 chains distant from and parallel to the low water mark at Penguin Island. (Public Plan 341D/40.)

The Proclamation dated 15th May, 1957, and published in *Government Gazette* (No. 47) of 24th May, 1957, is hereby revoked.

WHEREAS by sections 223 and 225 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1958 (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the *Government Gazette*, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the City of Perth has requested that certain land named and described in the Schedule hereunder which have been reserved for streets or ways within the City of Perth, be declared public highways: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said lands to be public highways, and such lands shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as highways within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

M.W.S. 1402/58.

WHEREAS by the Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1909-1956, it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct, provide and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works and Metropolitan Main Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Main Drainage.

Eden Hill-Bassendean Drainage Area.

Brook Street Main Drain.

(a) Part of Section 3 Main Drain.

(b) Part of Extension Road Branch Drain.

Construction of pipe drains at the junctions of Brook Street and West Road and West Road and Extension Road, Bassendean.

The above works, together with all other apparatus necessary for the undertaking, as shown on Plan M.W.S.S. & D.D., W.A. No. 8355.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 8th day of January, 1960.
