WHEREAS by sections 223 and 225 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1958 (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the Government Gazette, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public

ORDER IN COUNCIL.
